 Dix, New Jersey. Overseas January 1944 to England.
 Landed in France shortly after D-day. Attached to 3rd
 Armored Division, 1st. Army under General Hodges. Par-
 ticipated in campaigns in Normandy, Northern France,
 Rhineland, Ardennes, Central Europe.
 Received Good Conduct Medal, Silver Star, E.T.O. and
