

Hardin Conservation District 5-5-66 Enters National Competition

The Hardin Soil Conservation District will compete in the 20th annual Goodyear competition to select the top 53 districts in the nation, said district chairman Paul Primus of Seamboat Rock.

Soil conservation efforts during this year will count for the contest, sponsored by the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co. The winning district will send a director and an outstanding farmer-cooperator to Arizona for a work-study trip in December of next year. The sponsor operates a 14,000 farm operation near Phoenix.

Hardin County won the state competition in 1962. There are 740 farm operators in the district program this year. Nationally there are more than two million operators in the program.
