All Foreman:-

We have exceeded our 1926 tie allotment 5234 ties. Herewith revised allotment for 1927. We must not exceed our tie allotment during the season of 1927 this is final. You must so distribute your ties in 1927 so will take care of all bad places and not figure on installing ties so as to make some miles 100% and other spots go without renewals. From now on keep your tie allotment in mind and see that you get the most out of your tie allotment of 1927. Treated hemlock are classified as Oak.
