- age of the heart. The deceased had
5 been in good health considering her
age, until about ten months ago she
6 began to show signs of a weakened
7 heart and her decline from that time,
8 while not rapid, has been gradual.

3 Amelia Hilleman was born at Her-
4 zog, Brunswick, Germany, May 31,
5 1829. In the spring of 1865 the family
6 emigrated to this country, settling first
7 at Plano, Illinois. A year later they
8 moved to the French Grove settlement
9 in this county, where they occupied a
10 farm for many years, later moving
11 into town. Besides her son she is
12 survived by two brothers. They are
13 Henry and Frederick Hilleman, both
14 of this place.

Deceased was a conscientious Lu-
- theran and a faithful church member.
She was of a kind and benevolent dis-
- position and consequently had a large
circle of friends who highly respected
her. Their sympathy was manifest
in the days of her last sickness.

Funeral services were held at St.
Paul's Lutheran church Monday af-
- ternoon, Rev. J. G. Oltmann, the
pastor officiating. Interment was
made in Hillside cemetery.

Aged Resident of State Center Dies of Old Age.

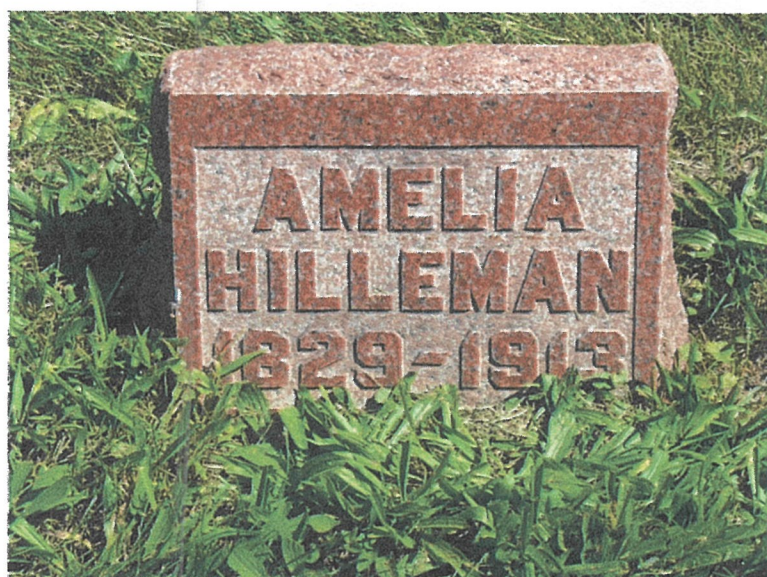
After an illness due to the infirmities of age Mrs. Amelia Hilleman, an aged resident of State Center, died at 5 o'clock this morning at the home of her son, F. A. Hilleman.

Mrs. Hilleman was a native of Germany, where she was born May 31, 1829. She came to this country in 1850, and has made her home with her son at State Center thirty-four years. Two brothers, Henry and Fred Hilleman, live at State Center.

Funeral services will be held Monday, at 1:30 from the house, and at 2 o'clock from St. Paul's Lutheran church, and burial will be in Hillside.
