MISSIONER FOR THE HARDIN

EMBRACING LANDS LYING IN
THE COUNTY OF HARDIN IN
THE STATE OF IOWA

To all owners and/or operators
of lands lying within the Hardin
County Soil Conservation District,
comprising the territory describ-
ed as follows:

All land lying within the
boundaries of Hardin County,
Iowa, exclusive of incorporat-
ed cities and towns.

Notice is hereby given that on
the 9th day of March, 1959, be-
tween the hours of 7:00 P. M.
and 9:00 P. M., an election will
be held for the election of a com-
missioner for the Hardin County
Soil Conservation District.

All owners and/or operators of
lands lying within the above
mentioned territory are eligible
to vote.

Polling places for the election
are as follows:

Youth Building Wing, Fair-
grounds, Eldora, Iowa.

Eligible voters residing within
the District shall cast their bal-
lots at one of the polling places.
Eligible voters not residing in
the District, or who will be ab-
sent from the District on the day
of election may apply in person
or in writing to the County Au-
ditor at Eldora, Iowa, for "ab-
sentee ballots." Each applicant
for an absentee ballot shall state
his name, residence, location and
acreage of land owned or pos-
sessed, and interest therein.
