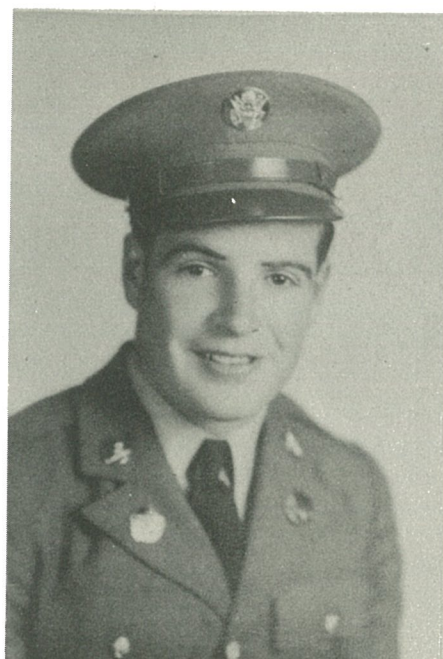




S/Sgt. CLYDE W. GLESSNER
