Barnett Falls, Back Injured

Clay Barnett of route 6 is being treated at Davis county hospital for a crushed vertebra he received in a fall from a garage attic.

Mrs. Barnett said her husband is expected to remain in the hospital at least two weeks for treatment of a back injury incurred when he fell about 8 feet to a cement floor.

Barnett, who lives on a farm southwest of Bloomfield, is a well known farmer and is chairman of the Davis County Soil District commissioners.

He went up a step-ladder into the garage attic. A cross-piece near the entrance gave way when he stepped on it, plunging him to the floor below.

Barnett was able to walk from the garage through the breezeway and into the house and was taken later for medical treatment in Bloomfield.
