Honey Comb Watershed Owners Elect James Bittle As Chairman

Ninety percent of the land owners in the newly formed Honey Comb Watershed met recently and elected Jim Bittle, chairman; Clarence Pieper, vice-chairman, and Gordon Rabe, secretary.

Discussing crop damage recently from heavy rains, farmers said the 1,900-acre watershed had an estimated 15 percent total loss and another 15 percent partial loss. It amounted to more than \$40,000 for all farms involved and would have been prevented if the watershed program was in operation.
