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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF IOWA
and the

HARDIN County Soil Conservation District

It is recognized that the protection of Pine Lake from siltation is dependent upon proper land use and erosion control measures in the Park and watershed. It is further recognized that there is a need for good and sufficient land use and erosion control measures on lands in and above Pine Lake. The purpose and objective of this memorandum of understanding is to set forth the basis of cooperation and responsibilities of the State Conservation Commission and the Hardin County Soil Conservation District for carrying out the intent of this memorandum.

It is agreed that:

- A. The State Conservation Commission of Iowa will cooperate and provide assistance to the District cooperators when requested by the Hardin County Soil Conservation District by:
1. Supplying funds if available to their cooperators in the Park or watershed of Pine Lake for the purpose of controlling erosion and preventing lake siltation, limited to the funds set aside for this purpose and to the amount specified on each individual agreement between the State Conservation Commission and the District cooperator.
- B. The Hardin County Soil Conservation District agrees to:
1. Supply technical assistance as available to Soil Conservation District Cooperators for the preparation of plans, surveys and specifications for erosion control and watershed protection and provide the necessary supervision for the construction and carrying out of said work plans.
- C. This memorandum shall be subject to change or amendment by mutual agreement of the State Conservation Commission and the Chairman of the Hardin County Soil Conservation District and shall continue until terminated by mutual consent of both parties or by either party upon sixty days (60) written notice.
