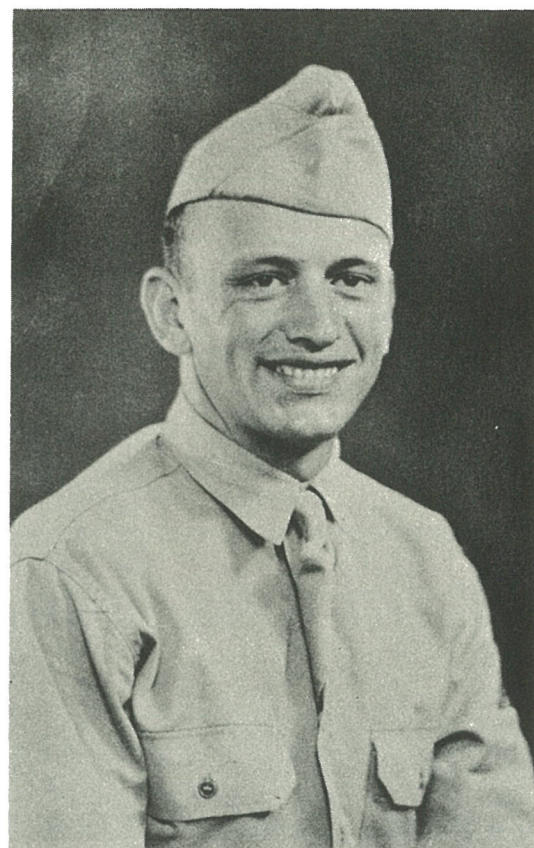




JOHN B. KAPUT

Enlisted September 1942, active duty, January 11, 1943.
Stationed at Omaha, Nebraska and Camps in Mississippi.
Overseas January 1944, to England with 69th Signal Corps,
3rd U.S. Army, under General Patton. Spent 10 months in
Germany, Austria and France; covered 1500 mile combat
area in Rhineland, Austria.
Returned to U. S. Honorably Discharged, November 3, 1945.
