Soil Stewardship Week Being Observ'd

★ Soil Stewardship Week, a nationwide observance which places emphasis on man's obligations to God as stewards of the soil, water and other related resources will be celebrated locally May 3-10, according to Dean Kelsey, Chairman of the Hardin Soil Conservation District.

This year's Soil Stewardship theme, "To Each Among Us - A Share" emphasizes man's responsibility as steward of our God-given soil and water resources — a time to focus attention on the kinship between man's spiritual stature and the soil and water resources on which his life depends — has been observed for many years.

The Hardin Soil Conservation District and some 3,000 companion Districts throughout the nation and Puerto Rico, through their State and National Associations, are sponsoring this event for the 10th consecutive year.

The Hardin Soil Conservation District has distributed especially prepared booklets to all churches of the county and church programs to those requesting them. These materials are prepared each year by the National Association of Soil Conservation Districts in cooperation with an advisory committee of church leaders presently consisting of representatives of all faiths.
