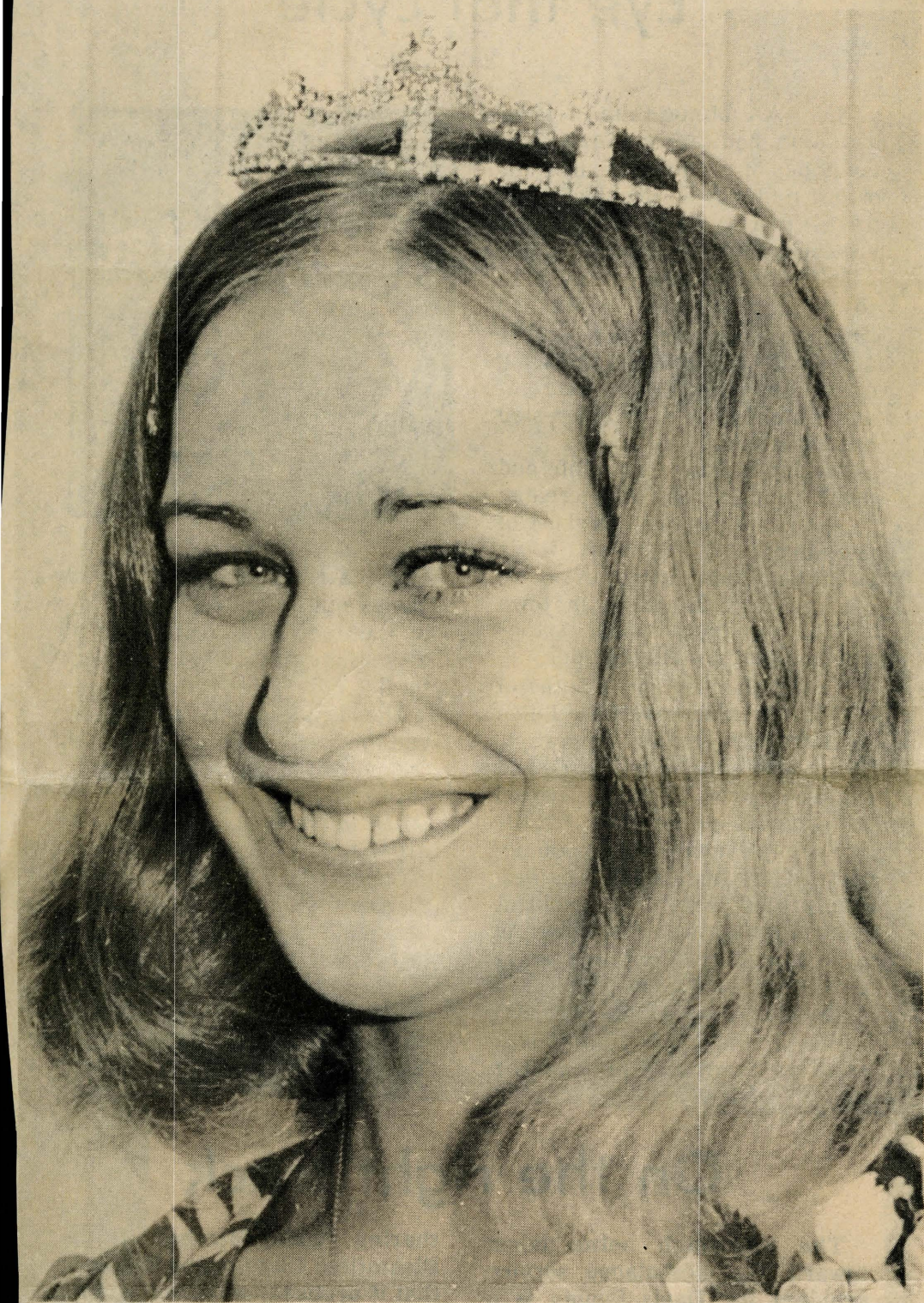




Conservation queen
