

Baughman Named Outstanding Soil Commissioner^{9/22/66}

Harold Baughman, chairman of the Davis County Soil Conservation District was named Outstanding Commissioner for Region 9 Tuesday at a luncheon in Cedar Rapids.

The plaque was awarded to Baughman by Al Bull, managing editor of the Wallace's Farmer magazine, which sponsors the annual recognition.

The award was the only one given in the 13-county region.
