Charles was born in DeKalb County, Illinois. In 1865, he, with his family migrated to Marshall County, Iowa. He later became known as a highly successful farmer and breeder of Shorthorn cattle. His wife Carolina was born in Canada. She was orphaned at an early age due to an accident suffered by her parents.

According to information supplied by older residents she was 'reared' by a Hilleman family. Following their marriage, Charles and Carolina Fricke lived on a farm four and one half miles northeast of State Center - the most southwest quarter section of Marietta Township, Marshall County, Iowa.

They later moved to a farm in Eden township four miles directly south of State Center (see pages 685 in The History of Marshall County.)

Charles and Carolina, best known as Lena were members of St. John's Lutheran Church, located north of State Center. It was here at St. John's Lutheran Church in August 1981, that records were found giving March 21, 1875 as the date of Charles' confirmation and February 20, 1887 as the date of his marriage to Carolina Kelling.

Both are buried in Hillside Cemetery about a quarter of a mile north of State Center, Iowa.

Both Gertrude and Albert were born at and reared around State Center, Iowa. When first married they farmed a little over a mile northwest of St. John's Lutheran church. From there they moved to a farm approximately three miles directly south of State Center. This farm was later sold when they purchased several acres of prime farm land with no buildings, located about a mile east of State Center, Ia. Here they built a beautiful, modern home and had erected the finest of farm buildings, so much so that their "place" became known as one of the outstanding farms in the state. The depression years which followed made it difficult to meet the cost and when it was sold, Gertrude and Albert with their family of four moved to Hollandale, Minnesota. The rest of their years were spent in and around the area of Albert Lea, Minnesota where they not only farmed but at various times were engaged in other types of employment. Funeral services for Gertrude and for Albert were held in Zion Lutheran Church in Albert Lea with burial following in the cemetery there.
