

To Take Look ^{7/23/63} At Watersheds

The State Soil Conservation Committee will be in Davis county Friday to examine Carter Creek and North Wyacondah as it prepares to decide on applications made for watershed assistance.

If applications are approved following the examination, the projects would be placed on a list with other watersheds approved across the state to await designation for planning priority.

Verle Arnold, work unit conservationist with the local conservation district, will accompany the committee, along with watershed directors, soil district commissioners, and a representative of the board of supervisors.

If the application is approved, it would be a matter of years before the project would actually get under way, Arnold said.
