Inducted in the Army December 16, 1942, at Camp Dodge, Iowa. Basic training at Camp Roberts, California. Sailed overseas December 26, 1943. Served in Pacific Theater of War; in 41st Division participating in the Invasion of Hollandia, April 23, 1944 and Invasion of Biak, May 27, 1944. With the 1st Cav. Division in the Invasion of Leyte, October 20, 1944, and Luzon January 9, 1945, being the first Division to reach Manila, Luzon, P.I. Received Good Conduct Medal, P.T.O. Ribbon. Honorable Discharge January 7, 1946, at Fort Logan, Colorado.



Cpl. DALE W. SMITH

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Elzy Smith. Enlisted in Army February 19, 1946 at Ft. Snelling, Minn. Received Basic Training at Fort Knox, Kentucky, and was later sent to Camp Stoneman, California. Sent overseas June, 1946, arriving in Japan, July 5, 1946. At the present time, stationed with 4th Replacement Depot with 2nd Battalion, about 25 miles from Tokyo.
