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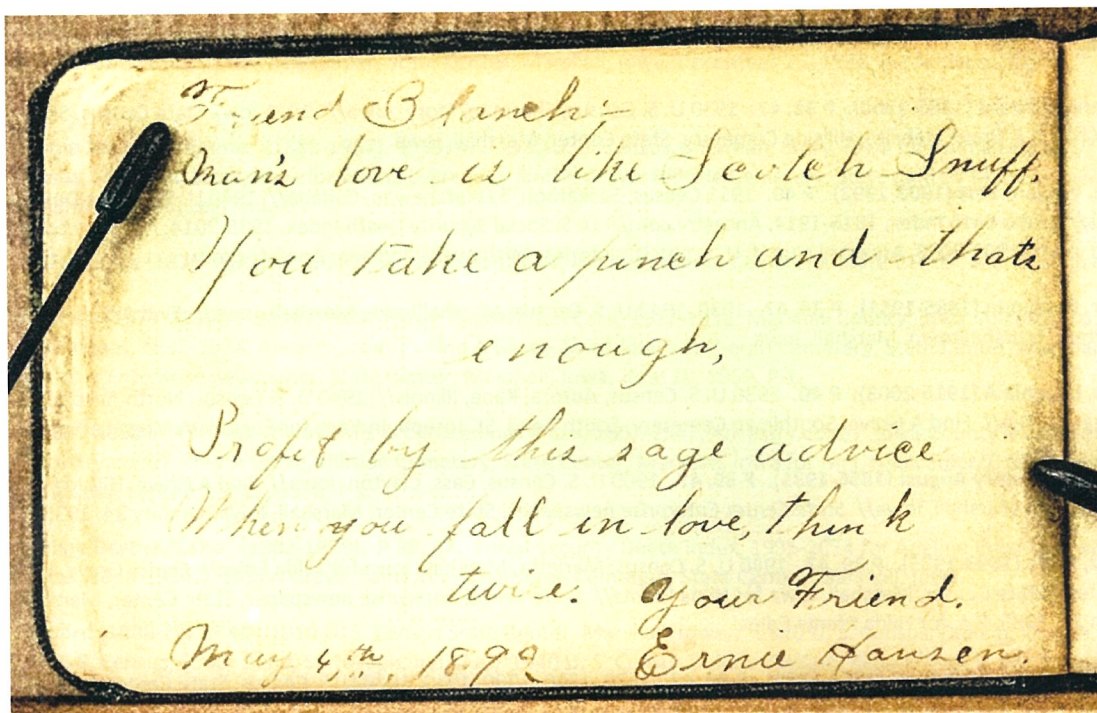

Ernie Hansen

Ernest Lyle Hansen "Ernie" was born on August, 26, 1876 in State Center, Iowa and died on December 25, 1957 in Santa Cruz County, California. He was the son of Christian Hansen* (1848-1914) and Mary Starr* (1849-1934). Earnest's brother and sister were:

- William Edward Hansen (1873-1944) who married Martha Ramsey McFarlan (1877-1945)
- Leona Agnes Hansen (1886-1943) who married Chris Johansen Christensen (abt. 1876-?? but after 1940)

Earnest married Emma O Schroer* (1877-1911) in Marshall County on May 10, 1898. She died in Excelsior Springs, Clay, Missouri following a gall bladder operation. She also graduated from State Center High School in 1897. After Emma's death in 1911 Ernest married Myrtle Elizabeth Shugart (1884-1966); it appears they had no children.⁴¹ Ernie and Emma had only one child:

- Donald Wesley Hansen (1899-1974) who married Mona Blanche Palmer (1901-1984).

Ernest had many occupations according to census data: In 1900 he listed his occupation as a salesman, 1910 a manager of a granary, 1920 shipping clerk, 1930 Grocer, and 1940 service station attendant.

Additional Information about Ernest Hansen's father. His father, Christian Hansen, born in Denmark was a stone mason. At the time of his death in 1914 he was the manager of the Farmer's Creamery in State Center, a position he held for ten years prior to his death. To honor Ernest's father, the businesses in State Center were closed during his funeral service.

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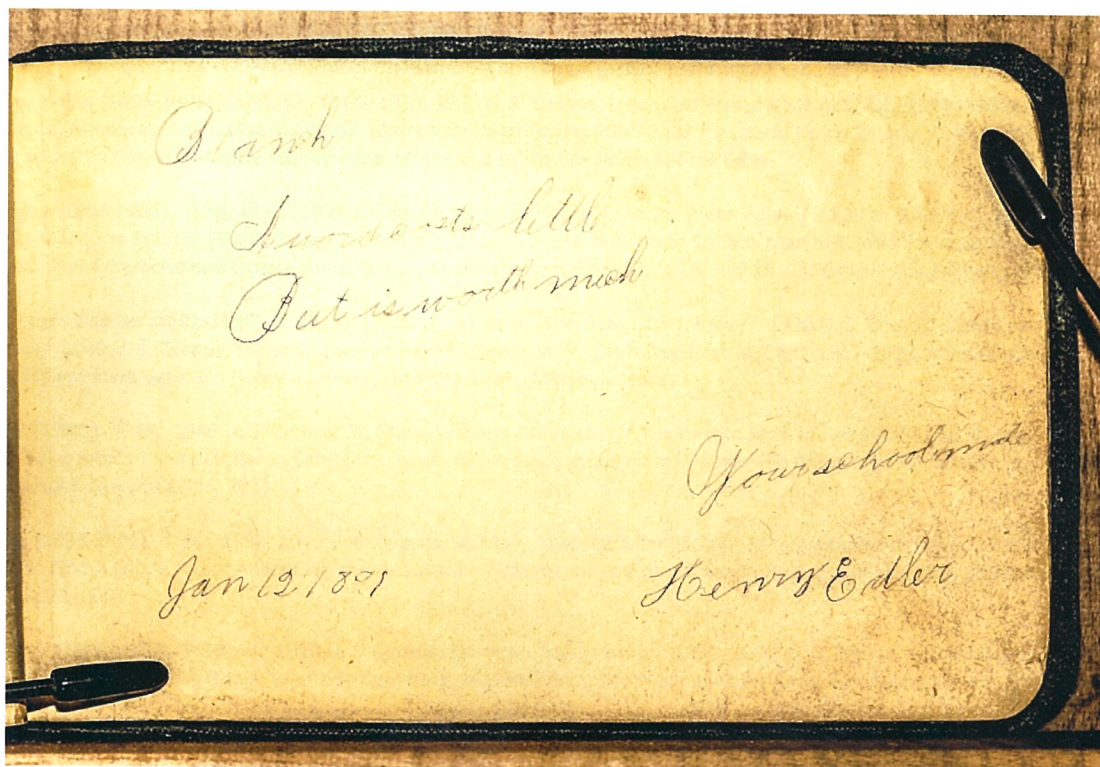

Henry August Edler was born into a large family of twelve children on January 4, 1880 in Minerva Township, Marshall, Iowa and died on December 4, 1966 in a nursing home in Jamesville, Waseca, Minnesota. He was the son of John Edler (1841-1913) and Alvina Eckhart (1853-1928). His brothers and sisters were:

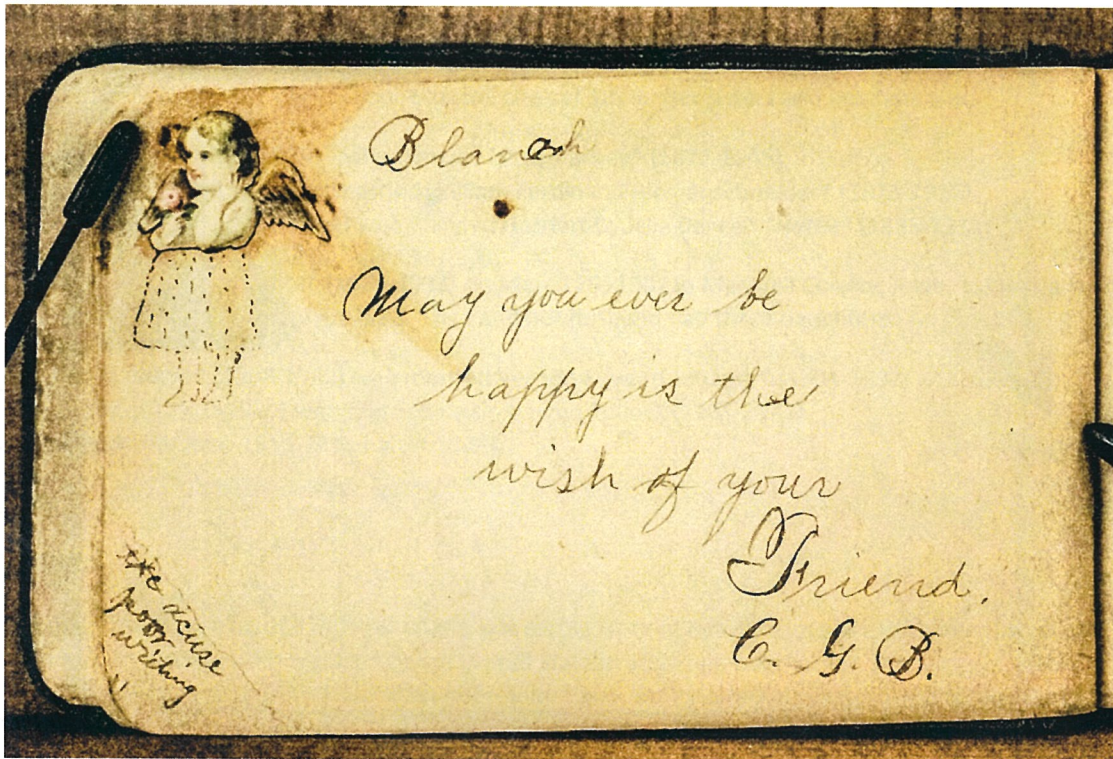

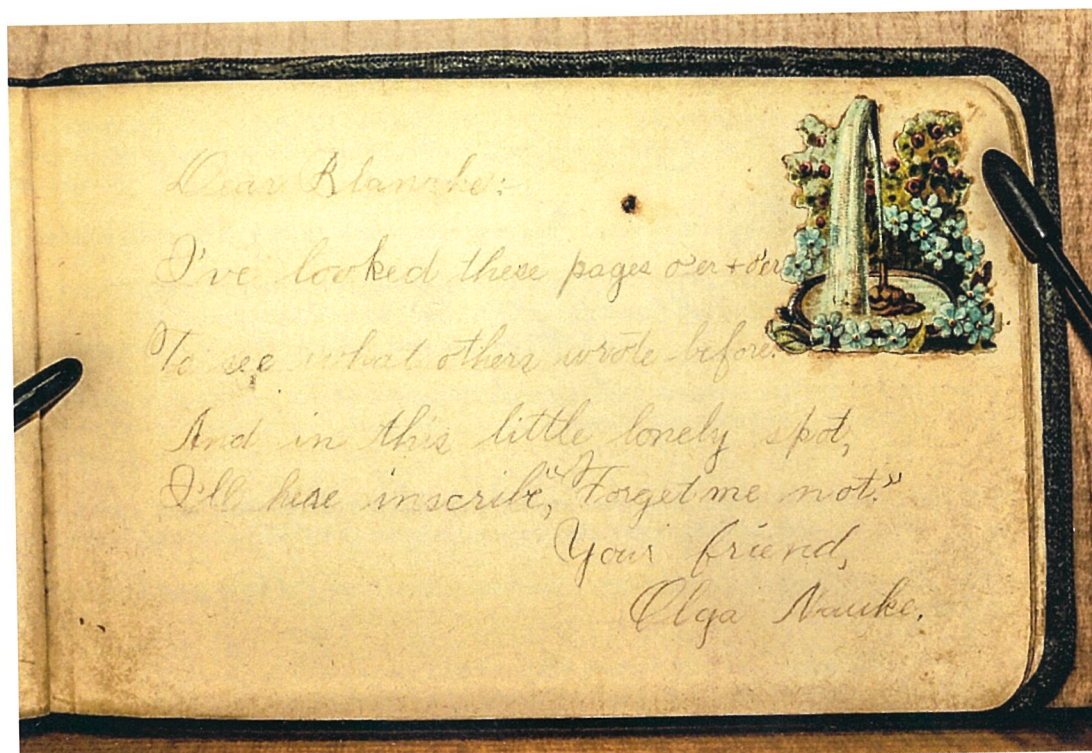

Olga Nauke* was born on November 27, 1877 in Story County, Iowa and died on September 16, 1973 in State Center, Marshall, Iowa. Her parents were Frederick Wilhelm Nauke (1846-1928) and Mathilde Koch (1847-1900). Olga graduated from State Center High School with the class of 1896. Her sisters and brothers were:

- Emma A. Nauke* (1875-1975)⁴⁴ who married Leroy Carney* (1877-1945)
- Alice Nauke* (1884-1914) who married William Ferdinand Riemenschneider* (1873-1916)
- Max Walter Nauke* (1882-1954) who married Harriett Louella Bence* "*Hattie*" (1885-1912)⁴⁵

Olga married William Frederick Miller* (1865-1938) on March 29, 1907 in Marshall County, Iowa. He was a farmer in the State Center area until his death in 1938. Olga and her husband had three daughters:

- Gertrude H. Miller* (1908-1982) who married Vernon Edward Schaper* (1904-1992)
- Viola D. Miller (1910-1989) who married Keith Kenyon Pollock (1905-1974)
- Francis W. Miller (abt. 1915-?? but after 1925).

Additional information about Olga Nauke's parents. Both of her parents were born near Berlin, Germany. Her father, Frederick, immigrated to the United State in 1854 and her mother, Mathilde, probably immigrated about the same time but immigration information was not included in census data until 1900 after her death. Like many residents of State Center Frederick was a farmer.

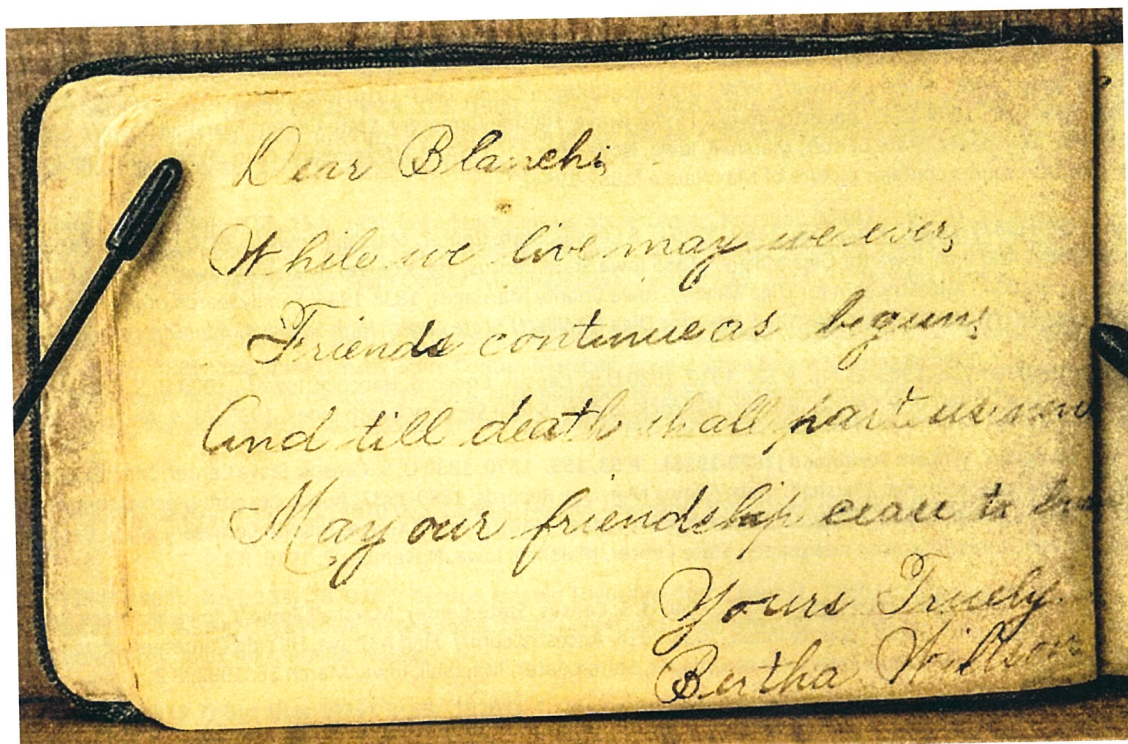

Bertha Luanna Wilson was born on January 24, 1879 in State Center, Marshall, Iowa and died on January 16, 1961 in Douglas County, Minnesota. Her parents were Lewis Wilson (1843-?? but after 1910) and Anna M. Paist (1842-?? but after 1910). Her father was a farmer. Bertha had only one sister as follows:

- Gertie Wilson (abt 1874-?? but after 1885).

Bertha was was a school teacher in the New Albany, Iowa area prior to her marriage. And then according to the 1900 U. S. Census, New Albany, Marshall, Iowa, her future husband was a border in her parent's household. About one year after that census, she married him, Adolph Edwin Pfeiffer (1874-1963), on August 7, 1901 in State Center, Marshall, Iowa. Not long after their marriage, they moved to Battle Creek, Michigan and then on to Minnesota where Edwin purchased a farm. In census data Adolph Edwin notes his native tongue as German and he emigrated from Switzerland to the United States in 1880. Later in life Bertha records her occupation in the 1940 census as a proprietor of a chick hatchery evidently to provide additional income for her and her husband now in their sixties. They had four children:

- Florence Gertrude Pfeiffer (1902-1992) who married Howard Scott Burnett (1908-1990)
- Harold Wilson Pfeiffer (1905-1998) who married Helen Louise Wolfsen (1906-1993)

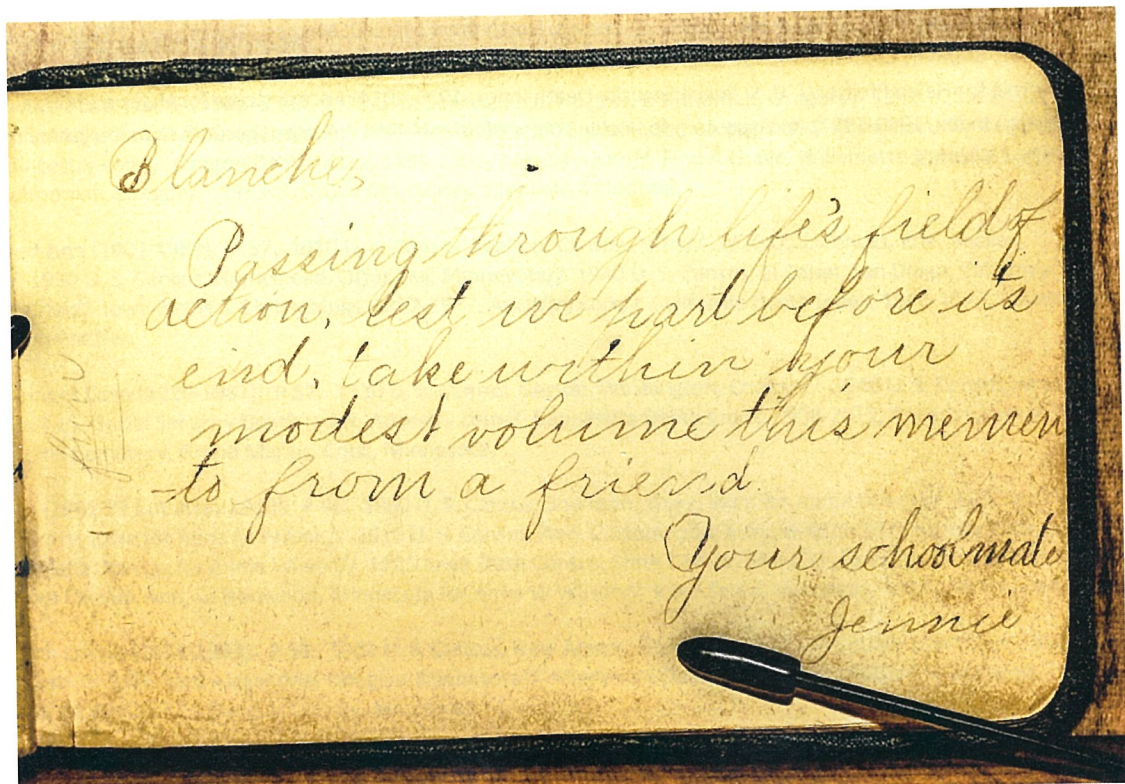

Jennie A. Vader⁵⁰ was born in 1876 in Marshall County, Iowa and died on May 22, 1960 in Elma, Howard, Iowa. She was the daughter of David Winslow Vader* (1824-1907) and Caroline Crook* (1833-1906). Her brothers and sisters were as follows:

- Timothy Vader* (1852-1897)
- Laura Vader* (abt. 1854-abt. 1875)⁵¹
- Emma D Vader⁵² (1854-1932) who married Silas Brown (abt. 1853-?? but after 1880)⁵³

- William Franklin Vader (1862-1942) who married Dora Francis McDonnell (1870-1918)
- David Grant Vader (1866-1928) who married Eunice P. Carney (1870-1939)⁵⁴
- Lena R Vader (born 1868-1941) who married Edward W. Mahan (1865-1940)
- Myrtle Vader (1874-1972) who married Frederick Heinrich Niedert (1871-1923)
- James Garfield Vader (1879-1959) who married Dennie Fern Vannoy (1890-1958)⁵⁵

Jennie married Henry David Niedert (1876-1941) on March 20, 1901 in Marshall County, Iowa. He was a farmer in State Center and later in South Dakota. Her sister Myrtle married her husband's brother, Frederick Heinrich Niedert (1871-1923) and both families moved from State Center to South Dakota to farm around 1914. Jennie and Henry had one son and two daughters:

- Arnold Allen Niedert (1901-1976) who married Eugenia M. Studeman (1902-1999)
- Irene Jean Niedert (1905-1984) who married Marshall Marion Hicks (1901-1983)⁵⁶
- Myrtle Aleta Niedert (1910-1986) who married Robert Dale Beach (1909-1971)

Additional information about Jennie Vader's father. Her father David Vader was a farmer in State Center, and declared in the 1895 Iowa State census "none" as religious preference. He was a Civil War Veteran and a prisoner for two years in the Andersonville Prisoner of War Camp the most famous of all Confederate prison camps of the Civil War. A prison stockade of 27 acres near Andersonville, Georgia held up to 33,000 prisoners. Sanitation was the primary problem. Prison authorities, visitors and Union prisoners remarked often about the fetid order that encompassed the stockade.⁵⁷

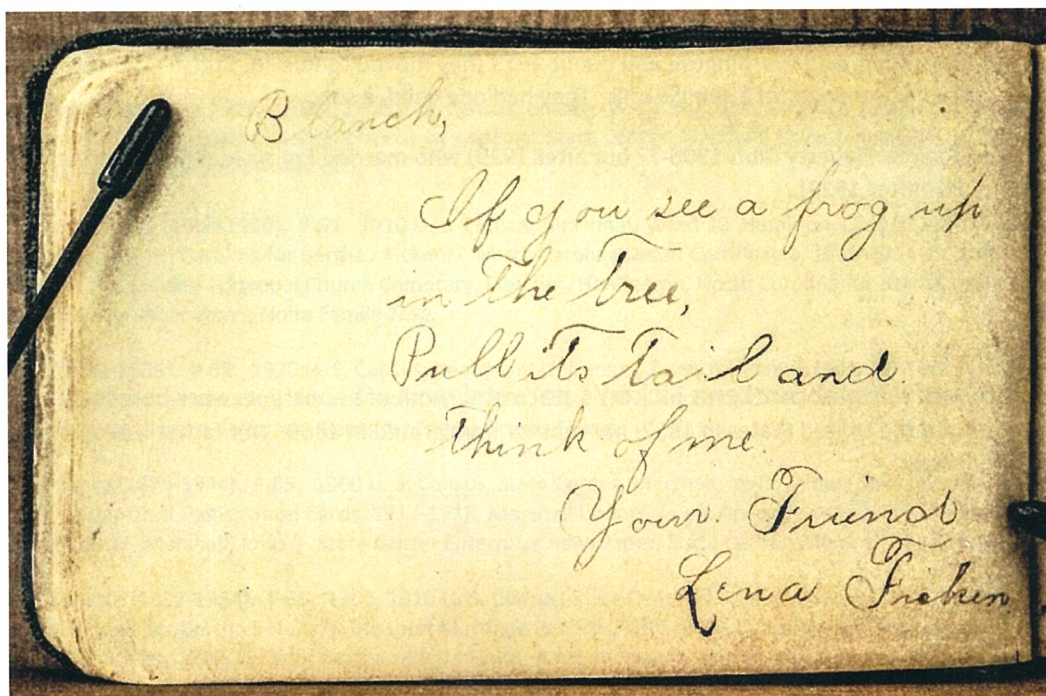

Lena Ellen Ficken was born in December, 1876 in State Center, Marshall, Iowa, and died on July 6, 1927 in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Her obituary in the State Center newspaper described her cause of death as follows: "Mrs. Flaherty recently submitted to an operation for removal of gall stones and her appendix but an inward goiter was given as the immediate cause of death."⁵⁸ She was the daughter of Charles Ficken* "Charley" (1851-1927) and Lena Miller* (1853-1926). 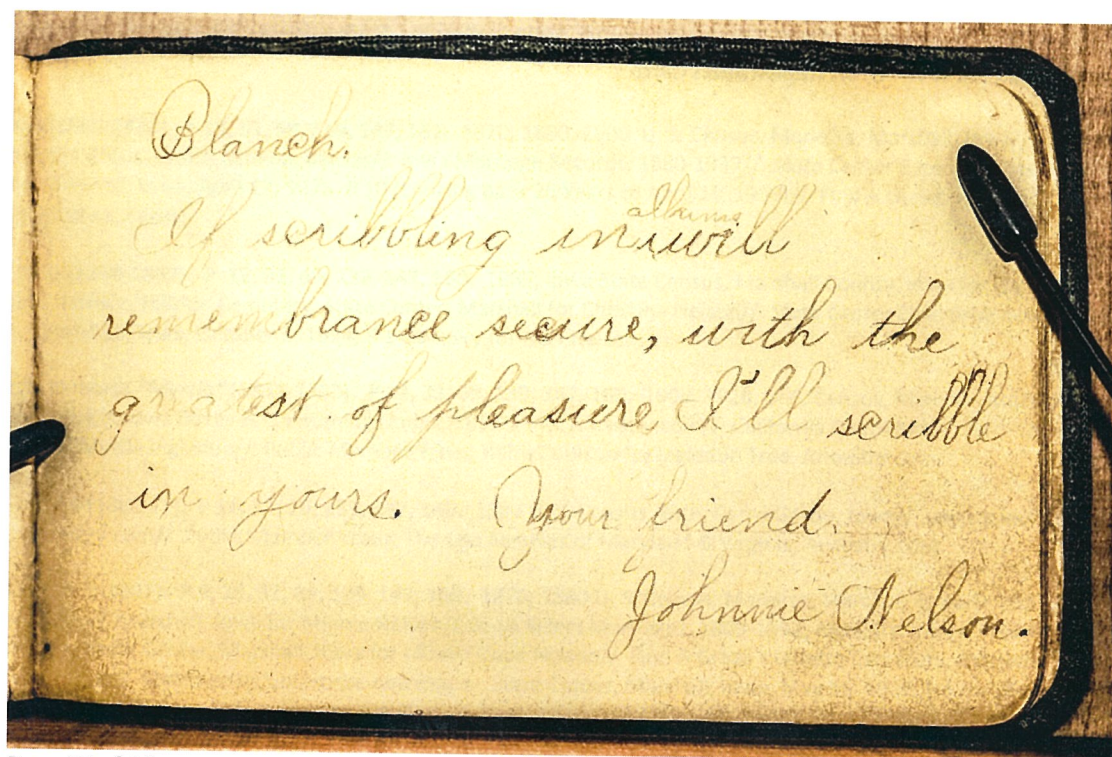

Effie Alice Whitehead⁶⁶ was born on August 10, 1880 in Collins Township, Story, Iowa and died on March 14, 1965 in Faribault County, Minnesota. She was the daughter of Malvin B. Whitehead (1845-1928) and Nancy Dille Besett (1851-1928). Her father was a four year veteran of the Civil War serving from 1861-1865. Her three brothers were:

- Dana Ellson Whitehead (1873-1942) who married Ann Elizabeth Alexander (1878-1951)
- Charles Edmund Whitehead (1878-1956) who married Rhoda Allen Caunt (1882-1959).⁶⁷
- Clarence Burnett Whitehead (1885-1947) who married Floy I Adams (1891-1977)

Effie married Arthur McCoy Westfall (1875-1955) on January 1, 1898 in Jasper County, Iowa. They had two daughters:

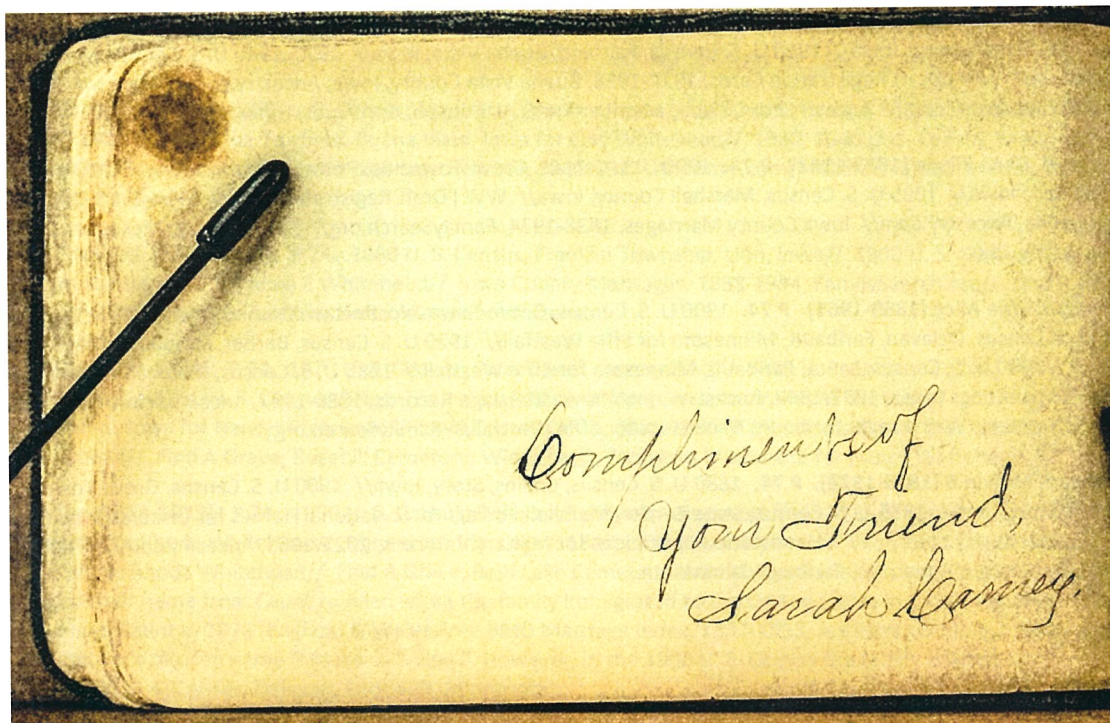

Sarah M Carney* was born in August of 1875 in Ringgold County Iowa and died on October 10, 1927 in Santa Cruz California. She was the daughter of John Wesley Carney* (1844-1915) and Elizabeth Jane White* (1847-1901).⁶⁹ Her father John Wesley was manager of the State Center Creamery after he quite farming in the early 1900's. Her one sister and three brothers were:

- Eunice P Carney* (1869-1939) who married David Grant Vader (1866-1928)⁷⁰
- George Horatio Carney (1872-1936) who married Harriat Adalade Fairchild (1869-1927)
- Leroy Carney* (1877-1945) who married Emma A Nauke* (1875-1975)
- Elmer J Carney (1884-1963) who married Mary Charoltte Leibsle (1887-1969)

Sarah married Edgar Eugene Nason (1876-1957) on December 22, 1897 in Marshall County, Iowa. I believe Sarah and Edgar had a good deal of grief in their life because their only two children died within a year of their births:

- Alvan Nason* (13 Sep 1898-14 Jan 1899)
- John Stephen Nason* (Dec 29, 1912-Nov 20, 1913)

Her husband Edgar listed his occupations as a farmer. Sometime following their marriage they moved from State Center to farm in Dundrum, Saskatchen, Canada and again bad luck followed them. As reported in the State Center newspaper of February 19, 1914 their home burned to the ground in a fire along with their barn and machinery shed.⁷¹
