

Commissioners OK Cost-Share program

The Louisa County Soil and Water Conservation District Commissioners have recently approved cost-share for no-till planting, contour farming, and contour-strip cropping. The cost share program is simple.

The Commissioners can allocate up to 30 percent of their cost-share budget for these practices.

The following payments will be allowed: For no-till planting, the Commissioners will pay \$10/acre up to 40 acres. For contouring, they will pay \$6 per acre up

to 80 acres. For contour-strip cropping, they will pay \$15 per acre up to 80 acres. The practices of contouring and contour-strip cropping must be maintained for a 5 year period. The no-till must be used two years but can be on different areas each year.

SCS assistance is available for the layout of contour-strip cropping. The office is located at 514 Isett in Wapello, 523-6411.

Deadline for sign-up will be June 1, 1990.
