

Soil Group To Hear Plambeck

Herb Plambeck, veteran WHO and WHO-TV Farm Director of Des Moines will be the featured speaker at the Hardin Soil Conservation District banquet to be held Saturday, March 26 at the Hardin County Youth Building, Eldora at 6:30 p. m.
