

Eugene Francis Trains in Ohio

Eugene Francis of route 7, Bloomfield, conservation aide for the Davis County Soil Conservation District, returned Saturday after completing a sub-professional training course at the U. S. Department of Agriculture soil conservation center near Coshocton, Ohio.

The training included courses in soils and land, biology, forestry, cartography, engineering, hydrology and agronomy. The training center serves 22 states and 17 men from 10 states attended the past session.

Francis, who lives on a farm eight miles south of Bloomfield, has worked for the local district since 1955, serving for the past two years under the supervision of Verle M. Arnold, work unit conservationist.
