North Wyacondah To Seek Watershed Help

BLOOMFIELD. — Farmers from the North Wyacondah area met last Friday at Pulaski and voted to submit a petition to seek assistance for a watershed under the Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Act (law 566).

The petition will be forwarded to the State Soil Conservation

Commission for review.

The watershed area covers 72,000 acres of which 19,000 are in Davis County, 4,000 in Van Buren, and the remainder in Scotland and Clark counties in Missouri. The two Missouri counties have organized and submitted a petition for assistance.

Charles Harsch, Ed Whirrett, LaVerne Kincart, Vaughn Baughman, and Earl Traschel were elected as directors at the meeting Friday evening.
