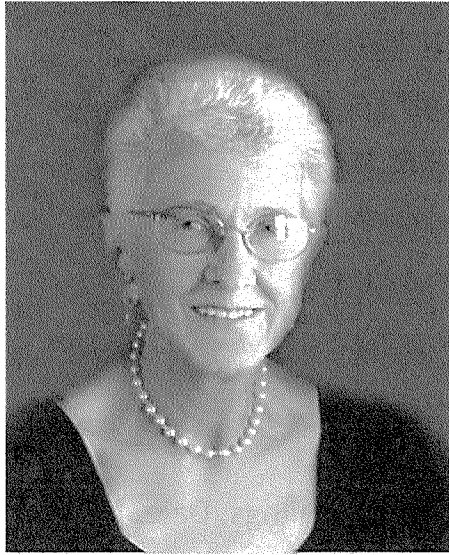

EXCHANGING KEYS was the symbolic gesture that finalized the change in ownership at the local hardware store Monday. Karen and Alan Hilleman and Hilleman's Hardware made way to Karen and Joe Hermann and the West Marshall Hardware.

New faces and a new phase at local hardware store

State Center — It's out and in at one of the Main Street familiar businesses this week, as Karen and Alan Hilleman, owners of the Hilleman's Hardware for the past 15 years, move on and make way to Karen and Joe Hermann, who will be owning and operating the business under the new name of West Marshall Hardware.

The Hillemans, who established the hardware business in town through the years, started the store from scratch in November of 1970. Alan, a graduate of Wartburg College of Waverly where he had earned a business degree, worked as an accountant at Spreads-All prior to the family's hardware venture.

The 15 years of owning a small business in a small town have been both a challenge and enjoyment for the Hillemans who will continue to be part of the State Center Community. ||

In a speech at the Commerce Club farewell lunch last Friday, Alan addressed his fellow business people noting that he and Karen will stay in touch with the business community here as well as go on supporting and participating in the community life. The Hillemans have two children, Kirk, who is freshman at Wartburg, and Kristine, a junior in high school.

Alan will be devoting his time into his work as representative of Century Companies, a life insurance firm, and Karen plans to give the life of a housewife and mother a shot this summer and look at some other

possibilities in the fall.

The Hermanns will be continuing the tradition established by the Hillemans in the store and plan no major changes in the operation. They will be keeping the same employees as well as the same business hours except that they will keep the store open Monday evenings, starting in June.

The Hermanns come to the State Center business community with a background in retailing and business. Joe, a native of Marble Rock, came to Marshalltown some 12 years ago and he continues his job at Fisher Controls as a designer.

Karen, who hails from Waukon, came to Marshalltown in 1978 and worked at Stevenson's in Marshalltown for six years after her arrival. She also has owned and operated a consignment shop in

Marshalltown and continues to have proprietorship of the Unique Angles, a home cleaning service which will remain open. In fact, Karen noted that people calling the hardware store will learn about "Unique Angles" quickly as the local store will answer the telephone calls for that business as well.

The Hermanns came to State Center initially to look for a house as they had considered the community a nice one and thought they would enjoy small town living, especially in this small town. They are still looking for a house as well as a buyer for their Marshalltown residence but managed to buy a business in the meantime.

The couple has already joined the local Commerce Club and Joe and Karen plan to be active in the State Center community.
