

Plan Field Day Tuesday

— June 19, 1963 —

BLOOMFIELD. — A Field Day program at the Southern Iowa Experimental Farm will be held Tuesday at the farm, five miles east of Bloomfield on Highway 2.

Cochairmen of the afternoon and evening event will be William Byers, extension director for Davis County, and J. A. Stritzel, extension agronomist of Iowa State University.

The program will begin at 5 p.m., with a general wagon

train tour of the experimental plots. A special feature of the program will be a discussion by Dr. E. P. Sylvester of the effects of preemergent herbicide sprays on demonstration plots of corn and soybean.

Also scheduled are oat and soybean variety trials; rock phosphate - superphosphate comparisons; effect of lime rates on corn, oats and hay; legume versus fertilizer nitrogen; effect of phosphorus and

potassium with and without manure; and high fertility plot on corn.

At 6 p.m., lunch will be served, courtesy of the Davis County Soil Conservation District Commissioners. At 6:30 p.m., the second wagon train tour of the plots will begin.
