Mrs Caroline Ambrecht, widow of Louis Ambrecht, an old resident of State Center, died at her home Sunday night of disease of the pituitary gland. Mrs Ambrecht had been confined to her bed for eleven weeks and had been failing since Christmas.

Mrs Ambrecht was born at Hagenbeck, Brunswick, Germany April 26, 1851. Her maiden name was Caroline Dora Thomas. When she was 14 years of age she came with her parents to America. The family first stopped at Sandwich, Illinois but removed soon after to a farm in the French Grove neighborhood. She was married there to Louis Ambrecht June 24, 1869. He died March 30, 1896 in State Center, where the family moved in 1878.

Mrs Ambrecht was the mother of nine children, of whom seven survive. They are Mrs Mary Woodson, Miss Emma Ambrecht, Mrs W A Bachman, Louis Ambrecht, August Ambrecht, Fred Ambrecht and Mrs P J Zahrndt. Three sisters, Mrs Henry Goecke, Mrs Henry C Hennis and Mrs John Ficken also survive.

Funeral services were held at St Paul Evangelical Lutheran church in State Center with Rev J G Oltman conducting the service. Burial was in Hillside cemetery.

EMMETSBURG MERCHANT DIES

Paul J. Zahrndt, aged 39, a hardware merchant of Emmetsburg, died at St. Thomas hospital in Marshalltown at 9:30 Tuesday morning of gall bladder trouble and complications. He was taken to Marshalltown Wednesday and submitted to an operation.

Mr. Zahrndt was born at Elkader, March 2, 1880. He grew up at Elkader, but when a young man worked at State Center, where he was united in marriage with Miss Alma Armbrecht, June 30, 1909. Later he engaged in the hardware business at Emmetsburg, where he had since resided. His father, Louis Zahrndt, died at Elkader, Oct. 19 of this year.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Zahrndt is survived by two children, Irene and Harold, his mother, two brothers and two sisters. The latter, all of whom live at Elkader, are Fred, Louis and Ida Zahrndt, and Mrs. Henry Gmelin.
