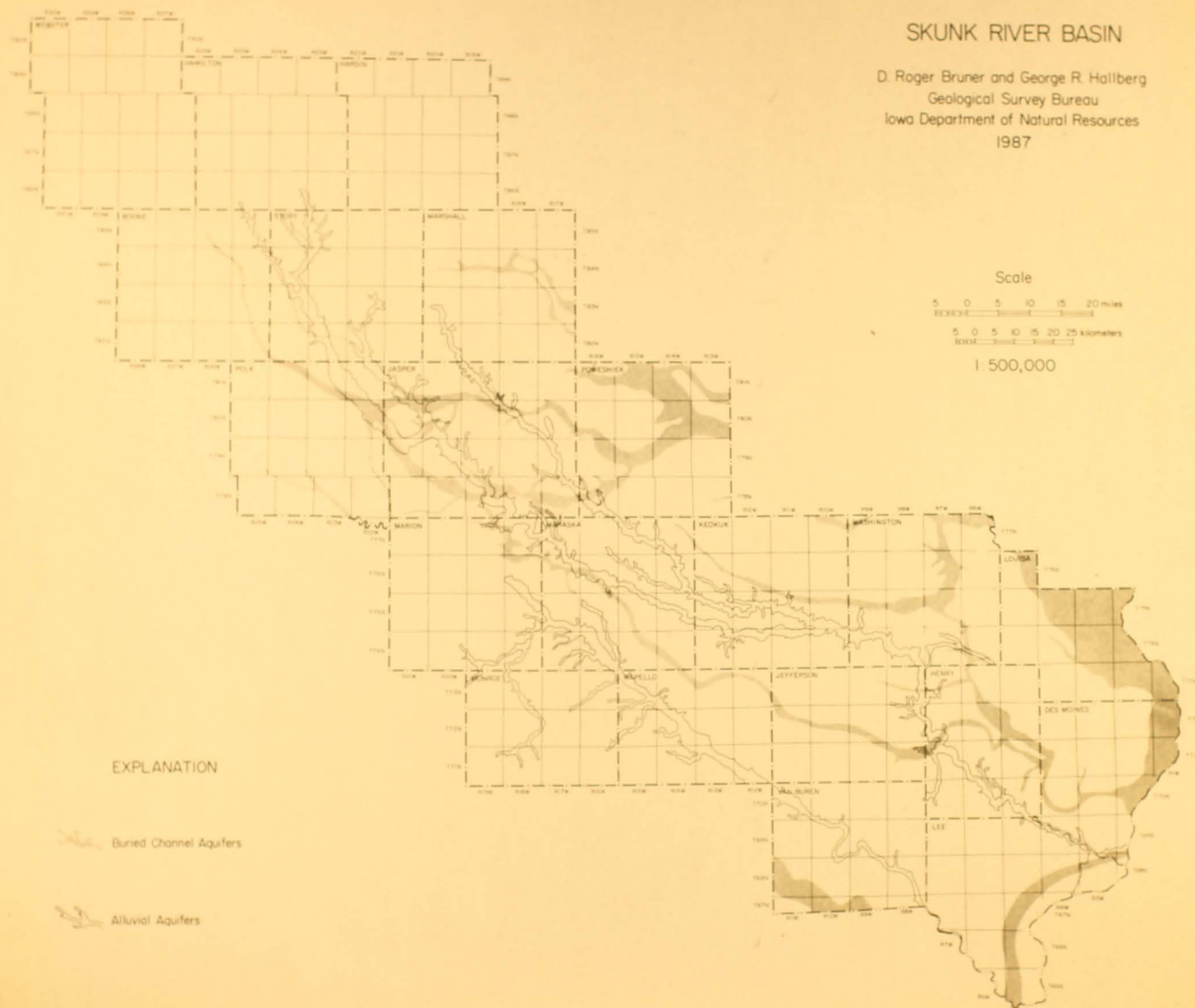


Plate 3. Approximate location of Alluvial and Buried Channel aquifers.

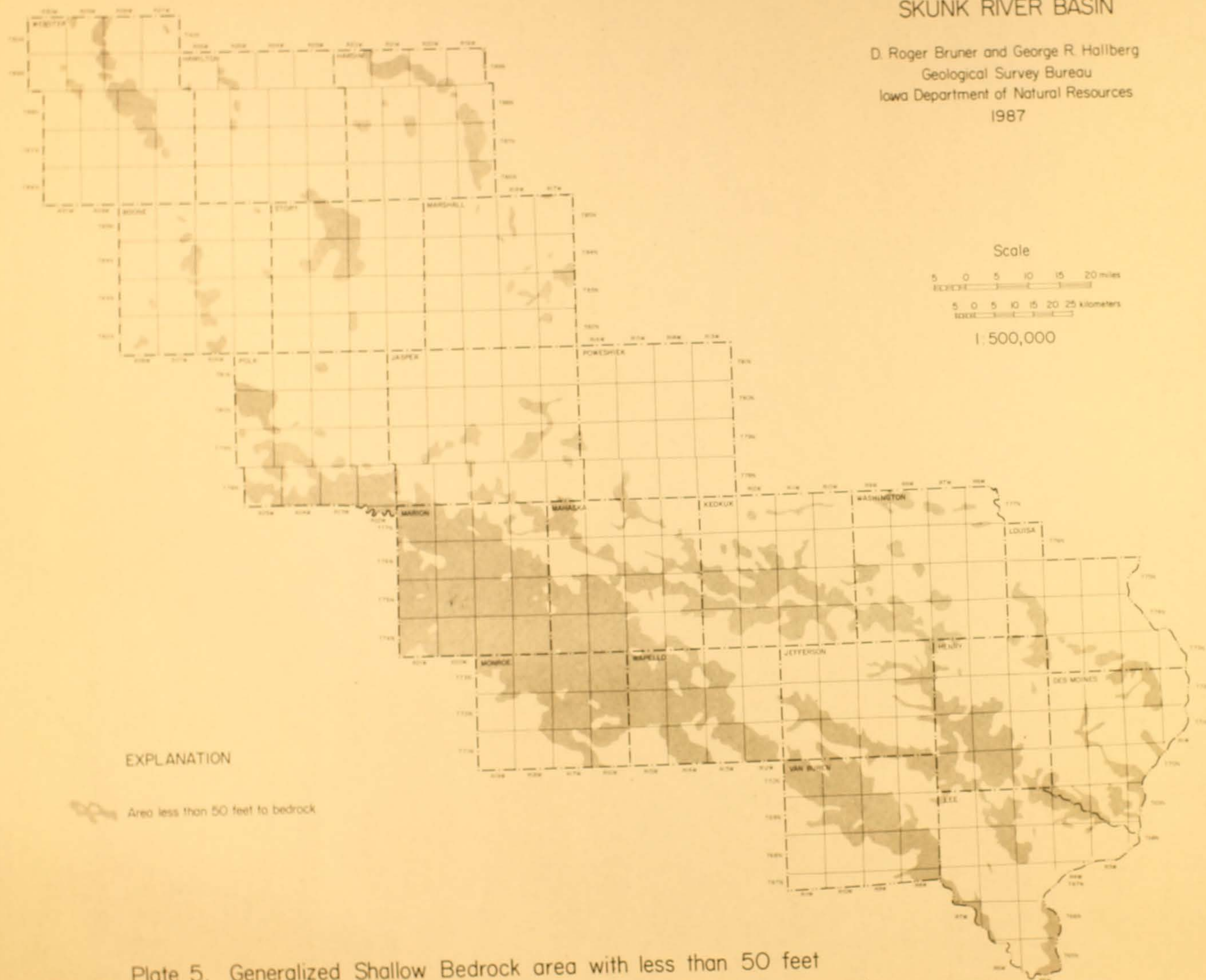
