Terracing Totals 11 Miles During 1958 In County

Terracing was the principal conservation practice carried on in Hardin county during 1958, according to a report for the year issued by the Soil Conservation Service in Eldora.

It was announced that 11 miles of terraces were built in the county during the past year. This amount was nearly twice as great as the 1957 total of six miles of terracing.

In addition to the new terracing, more than 1,400 acres of new contouring was established in the county during the year and about 20 acres of trees were planted on Hardin county trees during the year. About 1,096 rods of multiflora roses were planted and 28 acres of wildlife area were improved.
