SUCCOMBS TO UREMIA

Stricken with uremia Thursday, John Schmellik, Jr., died at 1:30 Sunday morning at his parents' home. Mr. Schmellik was a native of this country, having been born on what is now the August Schaper farm, seven miles northwest of State Center, Jan. 20, 1870. In addition to his parents, Mr. Schmellik is survived by two brothers and one sister. They are Christ Schmellik, nine miles northwest of State Center; Fred Schmellik, six miles northwest of State Center; and Mrs. Anna Funke, three miles northeast of the town.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 1 o'clock from the St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran church, in charge of Rev. J. G. Oltman. Burial was made in Hillside.
