

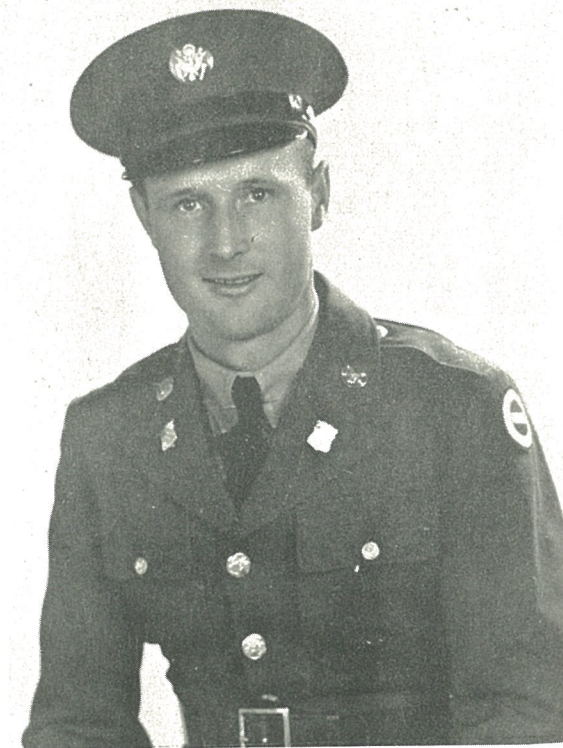


Sgt. CLIFFORD ARNOLD

Inducted into the Army November 14, 1941, at Ft. Des Moines, Iowa.

Basic Training at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina, Joined 197th Field Artillery Battalion of the 30th "Old Hickory" Infantry Division. 18 months in European Theater of Operations. Participated in Ardennes, Central Europe, Normandy, Northern France, and Rhineland Campaigns.

Honorable Discharge on Oct. 4, 1945, at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri.



Sgt. DONALD W. ASHTON

Inducted April 21, 1942.

Received Basic Training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and Camp Gordon, Georgia. Went to England for further training in February 1944, until July 4, 1944, sent to France and participated in Invasion of Normandy in the 18th Field Artillery. Also served with the 1st, 7th, and 9th Armored Division. Took part in 5 major Battles which included Normandy, Northern France, the Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe. Wounded December 16, 1944, during Battle of the Bulge. Received Purple Heart, Good Conduct Medal, E.T.O. Ribbon with 5 Combat Stars.

Honorably Discharged October 11, 1945 at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin.
