1961 DISTRICT ACTIVITIES

Ten regular meetings were held during the year.

The Annual meeting and election was at Burt, Iowa in February. Julius Baas was elected District Commissioner.

Soil Stewardship booklets were sent to each church in the County in recognition of Soil Stewardship Week.

The District purchased 200 copies of the booklet "Help Keep Our Land Beautiful" for the use of schools in the District.

The District was represented at the County Fair with a booth prepared by the Commissioners and State Aid. The booth was manned at the Fair by Joe Funk, State Aid and Commissioners, Jack Nyman and Julius Baas. In conjunction with the booth the Commissioners had a registration box. Local winners were Mary Casey of Algona, Iowa; and Eugene Casey of LuVerne, Iowa.

The Kossuth and Humboldt County Soil Conservation Districts jointly sponsored a soil judging contest again this year. The following Vocational Agriculture Departments were represented: Algona, Humboldt, Titonka and Swea City. The contest was held on the Glen Jenkinson farm. Working with a standard soil judging card the students were required to choose the principle features that would determine the proper land use for each site.
