

Announce Soil Speech Plans

Students of junior and senior high school are urged to get their names in early for the speech contest being sponsored by the Ladies Auxiliary of Soil Conservation District Commissioners, reports Mrs. Dean Kelsey, Iowa Falls.

"How Soil and Water Conservation Affects My Future" has been selected as the speech topic. The speeches, five to ten minutes in length, are judged on originality, aptness of thought and manner of presentation.

Awards of \$10, \$5, and \$3 are presented to winners on a county level. Local winner advances to the Regional Contests where prizes of \$25, \$15 and \$5 are presented.

First place winner in the regional contest advances to the State contest to be held during the Annual Conference of District Commissioners. Prizes of \$50, \$25 and \$25 are awarded in the latter contest.

Entrants are to notify the Hardin Soil Conservation District office, Post Office Building, Eldora, by April 1, 1960. The District office also has material available to help in speech preparation. Larry Kruger, Radcliffe, was local and regional winner from this area last year.
