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Hardin County Zoning Commission Recommends Approval Of Four Land-Use Classifications

ELDORA — The Hardin County Zoning Commission recommended approval Monday of four applications for land-use classifications within the county. Approval is in the hands of the Board of Supervisors.

Included in the applications were two from Sherman township to enlarge cattle feeding operations. Approval was given both subject to final approval by the county of lagoon-type sewage disposal systems. The applications were from Richard Topp and Edward Bossard.

The applications sought to enlarge each lot to accommodate 1,000 head of cattle.

Approval was also given an application from Gordon Reisinger of Eldora to locate a horse sale barn east of the Training School at Eldora.

Finally, the Zoning Commission looked with favor on an application for a land use change east of Eldora to erect a pipeline pumping station.
