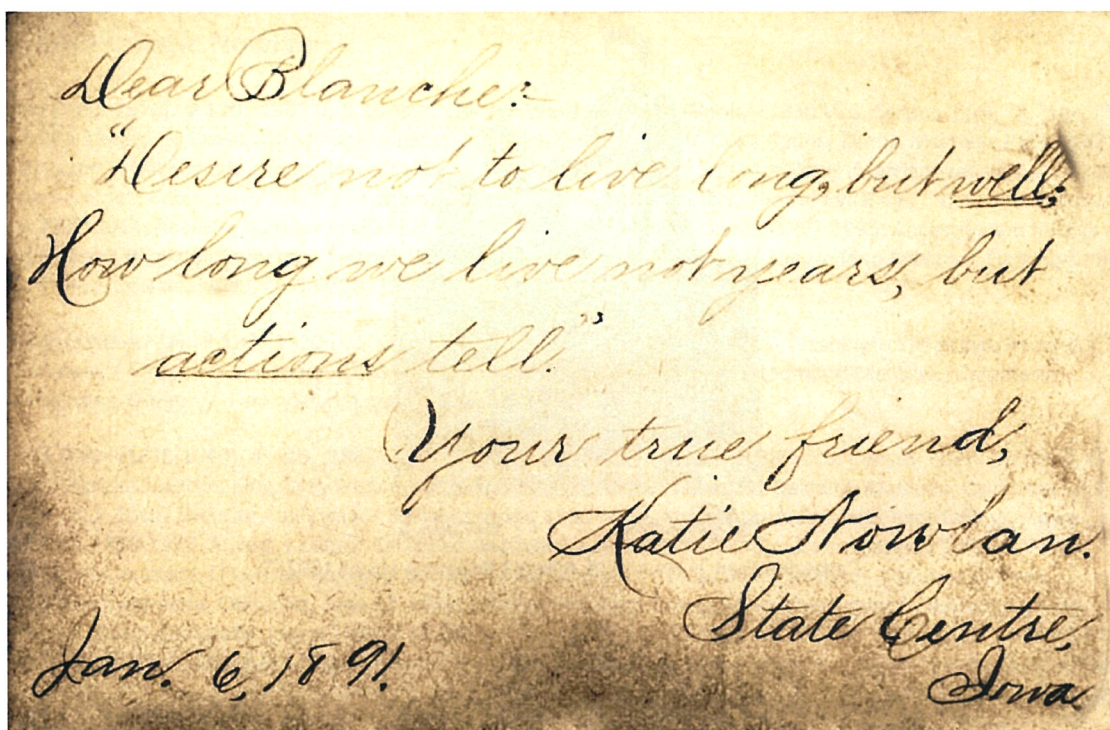

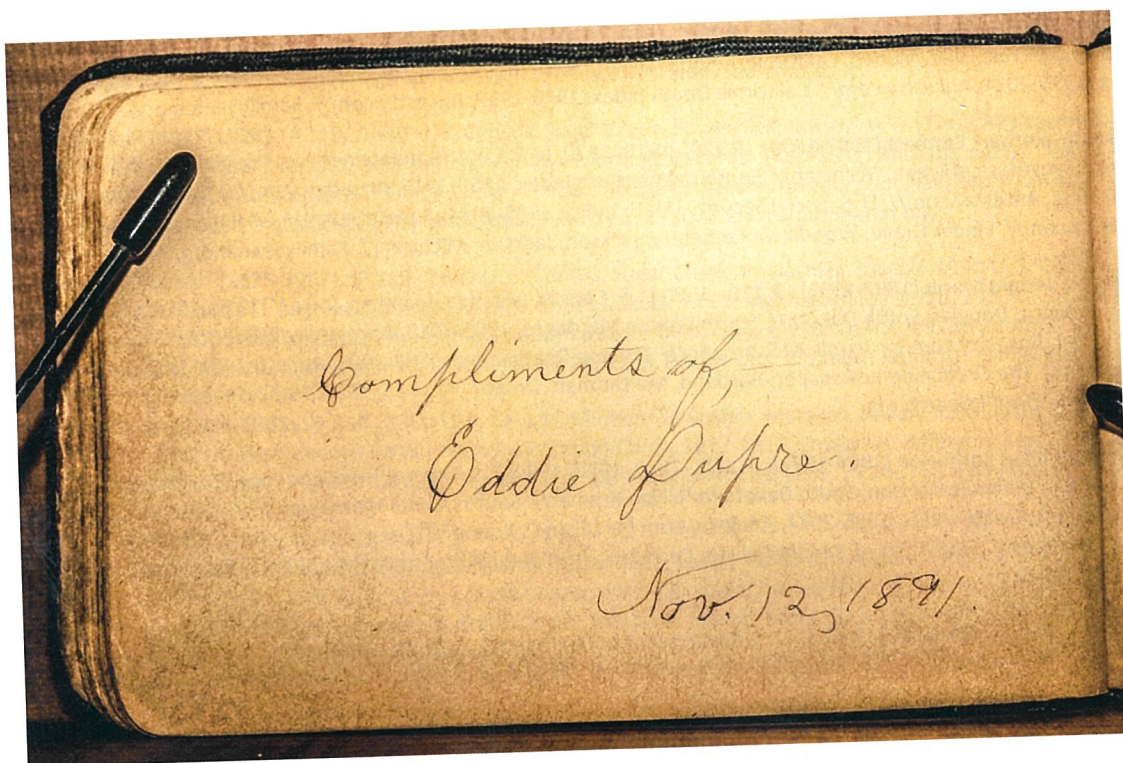

Edward August Dupre* "Eddie" was born May 10, 1877¹⁰⁵ probably in State Center, Marshall, Iowa and died on January 26, 1896 again probably in State Center, Marshall, Iowa. He died at the young age of 18, just five years after he signed the album. He was the son of Hubert Bernhart Dupre* (1847-1921) and Katherine Rilling* (1853-1933). His brother and two sisters were:

- Louise Sophia Dupre* "Lizzie" (1873-1966) who married Daniel Kurz* (1857-1919)¹⁰⁶
- Robert Hubert Dupre (abt. 1875-?? but died in infancy)
- Emma Marie Dupre* (1879-1910)

Hubert Bernhart was a painter in State Center. Both Hubert and Katherine were immigrants and born in Germany. His father was born into a Catholic home but after his marriage to Katherine in 1872 he associated with the Lutheran Church. His mother, Katherine, was an agent in State for Nuborne Corestierre's a well-known maker of corsets. According to a newspaper account in 1922,

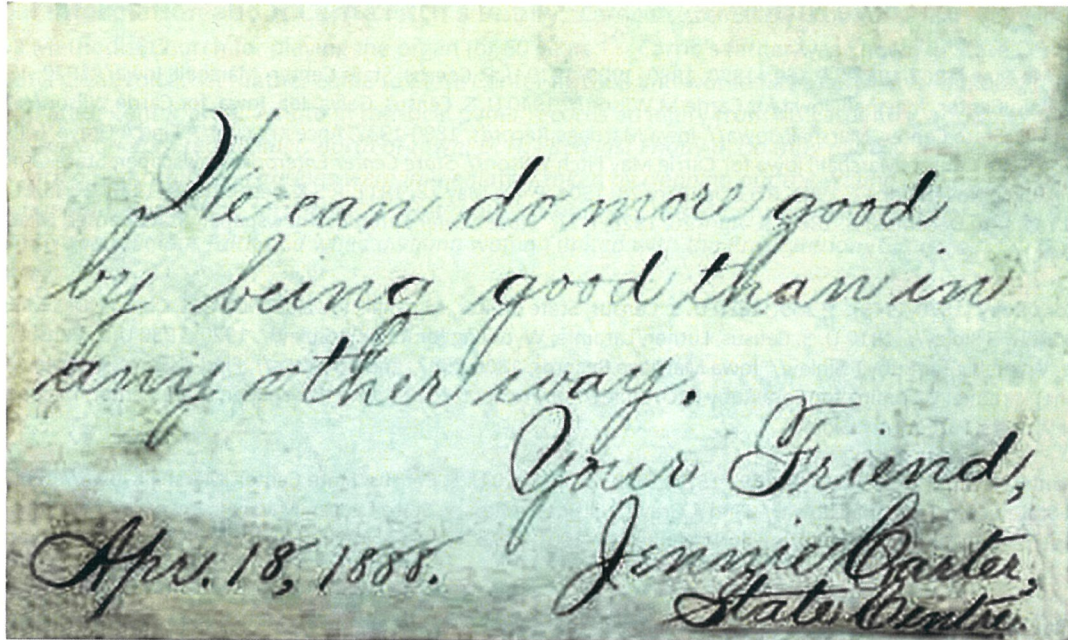

Additional information about Carrie Fitch's family. Carrie's sister Ella was honored in 1938 by the Galva, Iowa Methodist Church for playing the organ for 50 years.¹⁴⁴ Carrie's father was known in State Center as a vocalist with a great voice. Her father came to State Center in 1868 and worked as a carpenter, building many homes in the State Center area. A note in the local paper records an injury from his carpentry work: *"While doing some carpenter work for Fred Schuler, north of town, D. H. Fitch last Friday accidentally pierced the fleshy part of his right hand with a rusty nail. Precautions were immediately taken by cleaning out the wound and there is thought to be no danger of blood poison setting in."*¹⁴⁵ Her mother's obituary noted her religious devotion: *"Mrs. Fitch was a woman of strong religious faith and when a young woman united with the Presbyterian [C]hurch."*¹⁴⁶

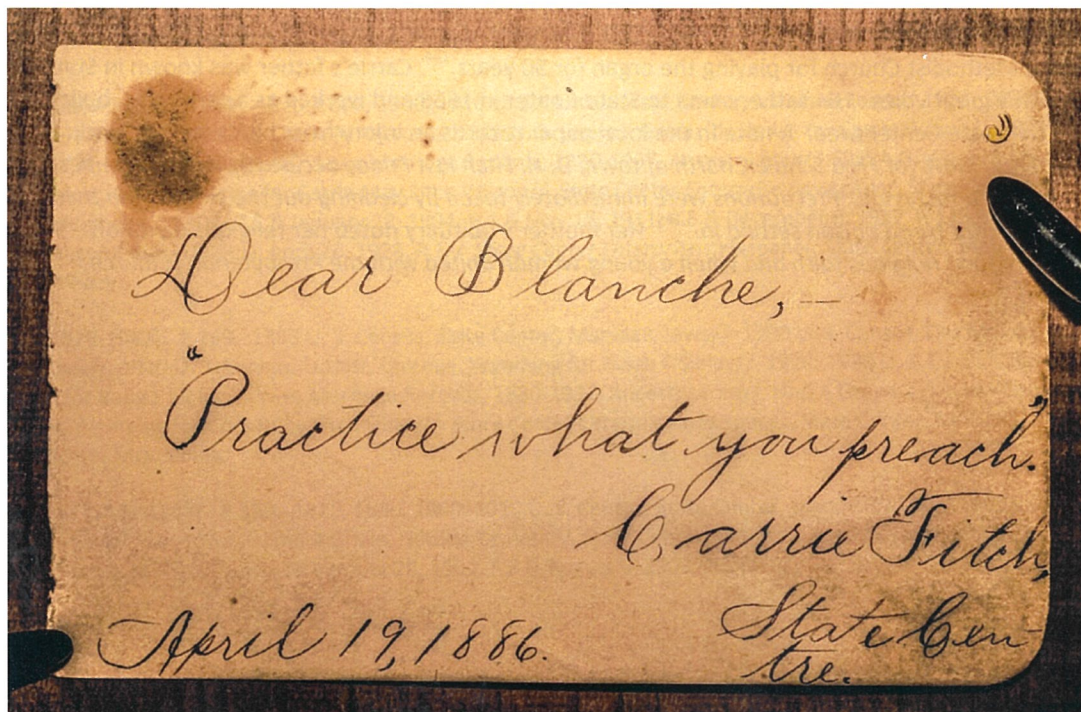

Carrie May Fitch* was born on May 26, 1867 in Lodi, Columbia, Wisconsin and died on October 31, 1947 in Galva, Ida, Iowa. She was the daughter of Daniel Haynes Fitch* (1834-1918) and Mary A Mills* (1840-1908). She grew up in a musical family. Carrie and her sister Ella served as organists in their local church congregations. Also, she was called upon by her friends to play the organ for their weddings and served as the organist for the State Center Presbyterian Church for many years. In 1911 the local paper reported a visit of hers to Cedar Rapids, Iowa where she expected to hear the Theodore Thomas Orchestra.¹⁴¹ Carrie was a graduate of State Center High School, the class of 1885, the second class to graduate from this high school.

A brother and a sister died in infancy; her two sisters who survived were:

- Ella Fitch (1864-1948) who married John M Lank (1859-1937)
- Cora Ruby Fitch (1870-1943) who married Stephen Hopkins Sibley¹⁴² (1858-1952)

Carrie was a school teacher and may have been one of Blanche's teachers. She married late in life at the age of 51 on November 14, 1918 in State Center, Marshall, Iowa to Eli A Wilson¹⁴³ (1857-1934). It appears they had no children.

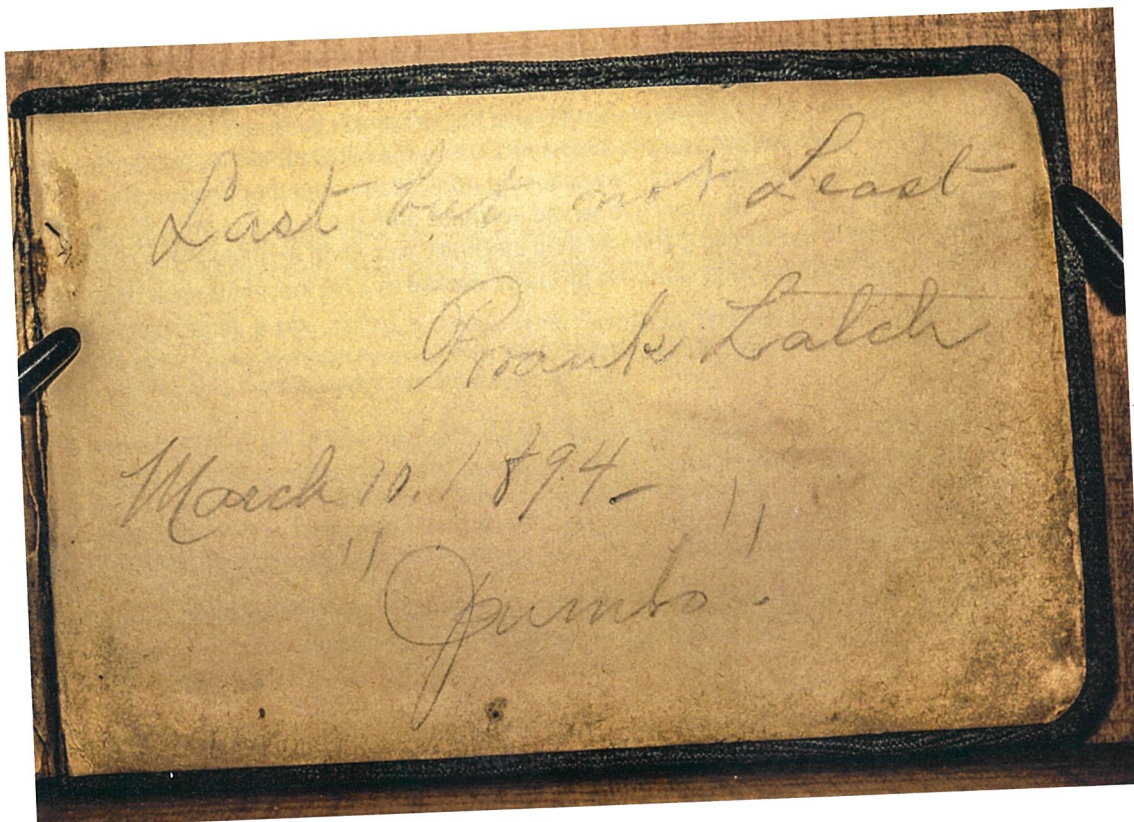

Frank did not marry but had a variety of experiences throughout his life. While living in Colorado with his sister Nellie Gwin he enrolled in the Canadian military in 1918 for WWI. It's puzzling why as a U. S. citizen he would enroll in the Canadian army. However, he did have ties to Canada because his mother was born in Canada and he lived in Canada for two years in 1913 and 1914. Information about his military service was not available but a note in the State Center newspaper in April, 1918 noted that he expected to "...leave for France in a few days."¹⁴⁰ He may have served in France until the Armistice on November 11, 1918. In the 1920 census he listed his occupation as shop mechanic and when enrolled in the Canadian military, he noted he was a "gasoline engineer". He probably worked as a car mechanic most of his life.

Francis Hill Latch* "*Frank*"* was born on November 24, 1873 in Decatur, Marion, Illinois and died on April 30, 1945 in Spokane, Spokane, Washington. He was the son of Theodore R Latch* (1838-1920) and Mary Ann McGowen* (1838-1912).¹³⁹ His family had moved to Decatur, Illinois in 1871 before Frank was born in 1873. In 1874 they moved to Scott, Champaign, Illinois. In 1882 they moved to State Center, Marshall, Iowa. His father was a farmer in both Illinois and Iowa. Theirs was a large family. He had 10 siblings:
