MRS. E. BOHRISCH, PIONEER RESIDENT SUCCUMBS MONDAY

**Had Suffered Heart Attack
In September; Funeral
Thursday**

Mrs. Emma Bohrisch of Van Cleve, 69, a native of the State Center community, died of heart disease at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Oscar Wehrman, about noon Monday. Mrs. Bohrisch suffered a heart attack in September and had been in failing health ever since. She had made her home with Mrs. Wehrman since her first illness.

Born May 31, 1871 near State Center, Mrs. Bohrisch was baptised, confirmed and married at St. John's Lutheran church north of State Center. She was married to Frederick Hilleman on Sept. 22, 1892, and he died Oct. 2, 1901. On June 15, 1903, she was married to Martin Bohrisch who died about a year ago. Until she went to State Center in September she had made her home on a farm near Van Cleve since 1904.

Mrs. Bohrisch is survived by her mother, Mrs. Mary Ann Riemenschneider of State Center, and several children, Mrs. Loretta Wehrman and Walter Bohrisch, both of State Center. Mrs. Leona Ramsey of Jamaica, Mrs. Eldra Amendt and Herbert Hilleman of Melbourne, Mrs. Ruby Davis of Colo and Fred Hilleman of Haverhill.

A prayer service was held at the Wehrman home at 1:30 p.m. today and other services were held at 2:00 p.m. at St. Paul's Lutheran church. Rev. H. R. Kumpf officiated. Burial was in Hillside cemetery in State Center.

Bequeaths Property To Seven Children

The will of Mrs. Emma Bohrisch, who died Dec. 23, in State Center, was filed Saturday for probate in district court. By its terms provision is made for payment of any obligation which may exist at the time of death to a daughter, Leona Ramsey, and then the estate is to be divided, share and share alike, among the seven children Loretta Wehrman, Leona Ramsey, Hildra Amendt, Ruby Davis, Herbert Hilleman, Fred Hilleman and Walter Bohrisch.

Oscar Wehrman, a son-in-law, is nominated as executor of the estate. Included in the estate is 160 acres of land in section 12, Logan township.

VAN CLEVE FARMER DIES AT WEHRMAN HOME WEDNESDAY

Funeral Services For Martin Bohrisch Here Sat. Afternoon

Martin Bohrisch, 69, longtime resident of the Van Cleve community, died of coronary thrombosis at the Oscar Wehrman home in State Center Wednesday afternoon.

Born in the province of Draushausen, Brandenburg, Germany, he came to America at the age of 22, moving on a farm in Story County. In 1903 he was married to Mrs. Emma Hilleman in Minerva Township. To this union, one son, Walter was born. Mr. Bohrisch has lived on his farm near Van Cleve for the last 35 years.

Besides his wife and son, he is survived by six step children, Mrs. Loretta Wehrman of State Center, Mrs. Leona Ramsey of Jamaica, Mrs. Ruby Davis of Colo. Mrs. Ildra Armendt, Herbert Hilleman, and F. H. Hilleman of Van Cleve.

Funeral services will be held at the Wehrman home at 1:00 P. M. Saturday and from St. Paul's Lutheran church at 1:30 P. M. Burial will be in Hillside Cemetery.

Vancleve Man Dies At State Center

State Center — (Special) —
Martin Bohrish, 69, of Vancleve died here at 8 p. m. Wednesday at the home of his stepdaughter, Mrs. Oscar Wehrman, with whom he and Mrs. Bohrish had been spending much of the time this winter. Death was caused by coronary thrombosis.

Mr. Bohrish was born at Brandenburg, in the province of Drauchausen, Germany, Jan. 18, 1871, and came to America when he was 22 years old, settling on a farm in Story county, Iowa. In 1903 he married Mrs. Emma Hilleman in Minerva township and they went immediately to a farm near Vancleve which since was their home.

He was the father of one son, Walter, of Vancleve. Besides his widow and son he is survived by six stepchildren, Mrs. Leona Ramsey of Jamaica, Iowa, Mrs. Ruby Davis of Colo, Mrs. Ildra Armanet, Herbert and F. H. Hilleman, all of Vancleve, and Mrs. Wehrman.

ring, Bill Mahlow of McCallsburg, Fred Honeck and Chris Schmellik. Burial was in Hillside cemetery.

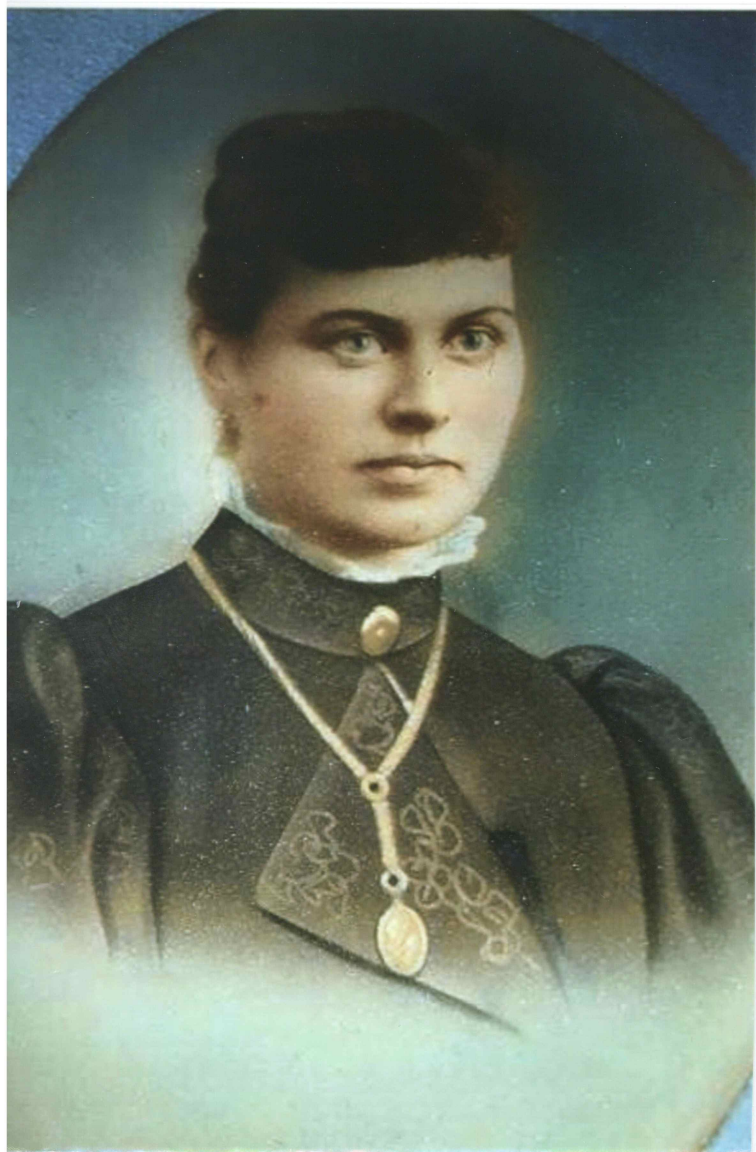
