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Conservation Art Contest Friday

The annual Hardin County Soil Conservation art contest will be held Friday, May 23.

All students enrolled in Hardin county schools, grades eight through 12, are eligible to enter the contest. All entries must be delivered to the First National Bank of Eldora by 4 p.m. Friday in order for the paintings to be judged that evening.

Entries are required to have a conservation theme. A panel of three judges and a conservation consultant will judge each painting on the basis of originality, use of media and execution of theme. A total of \$70 in cash prizes will be awarded to the winning entries by the Hardin Soil Conservation District.

Winning entries will be displayed at the First National Bank from May 24-31, and then displayed in various other Hardin county locations.
