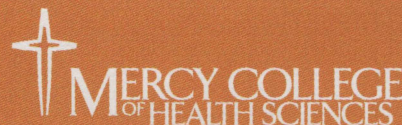

Scholarships Are Available

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR OF 2007/2008 are available on www.mchs.edu. The deadline for the first scholarships is April 20, other deadlines fall on April 27 and May 11th. Applications must be submitted to the Receptionist in Sullivan Center by the date noted on the application at 4:30 p.m.

Students are not eligible to receive more than one scholarship in a 12-month period in the same scholarship. NEW Scholarship Announced- Schildberg Foundation Student Scholarship

FUNDED SOLELY BY THE SCHILDBERG FOUNDATION, THESE SCHOLARSHIPS are awarded to two new students beginning their professional program of study and two students entering the second year of their professional program in fall 2007-08. Eligible candidates must list a home address within one of the following Iowa counties: **Adair, Adams, Cass, Fremont, Harrison, Madison, Mills, Montgomery, Page, Pottawattamie, Shelby, Taylor, or Union.** In addition, candidates must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale at the time of the scholarship deadline and demonstrate a financial need. Of special note: recipients will be required to submit a progress report to the foundation on their academic achieve each semester they receive funds, or risk losing further funding. **Deadline to submit is May 11, 2007.**
