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Corn Planting Equipment To Be Featured At Tillage Field Day

One of the featured items of the fall Harvest Day at the Quad State Minimum Tillage Field demonstration this fall will be a display of all the corn planting equipment used at the spring field day. This is located on the George Hoffman, Jr., farm, just north of Ida Grove, on Highway 59.

The minimum till machines and planting equipment will be on display throughout the day. Each machine will be stationed by the plot which it planted. You will be able to look at the machine, condition of the soil at this time of year, the corn crop, the weed control, the insect control and the yield data on each plot.

In addition there will be a demonstration of much corn harvesting, drying and storage equipment. Nearly 10,000 bushels of corn will be harvested, stored and dried throughout a day.

Don't forget to attend the Fall Harvest Day at the Quad State Minimum Tillage Field site Oct. 23. It will begin at 9 a.m. and be completed at 3:30 p.m. You will be able to see, in addition to all the minimum till planters, six grain dryers, 15 combines and various other grain handling equipment
