FEAR DIPHTHERIA EPIDEMIC.

**Six Cases Appear in Two Days in
State Center and Its Vicinity.**

A scourge of diphtheria, which

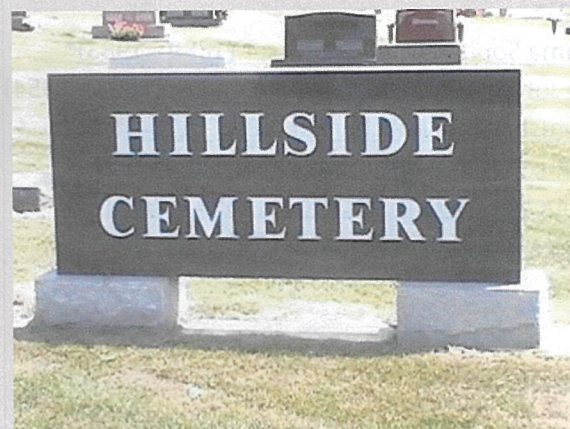

Besides a sisters, Mrs Mary Wengert of State Center, he is survived by a son, two daughters, six grandchildren, three great grandchildren, and a brother.

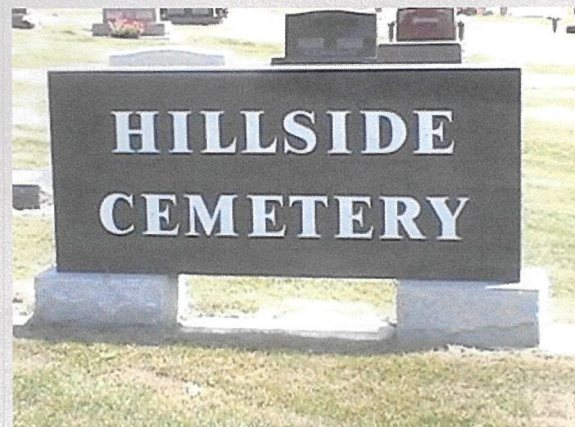

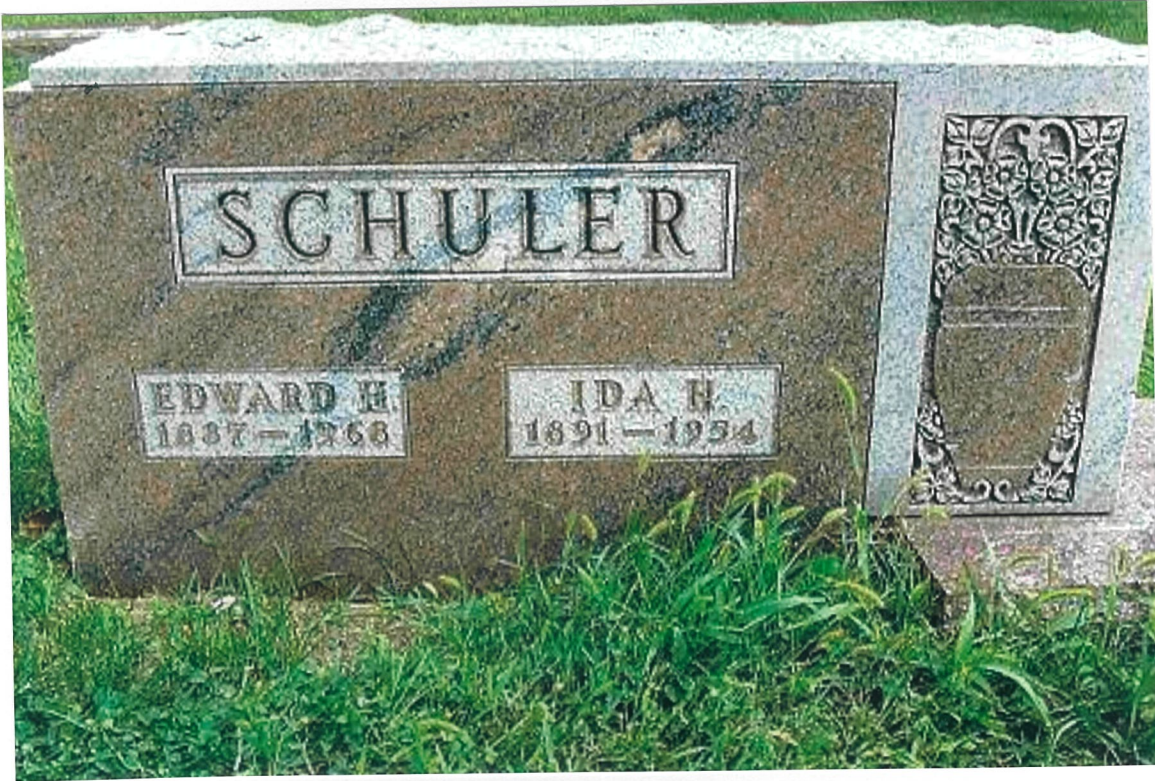
