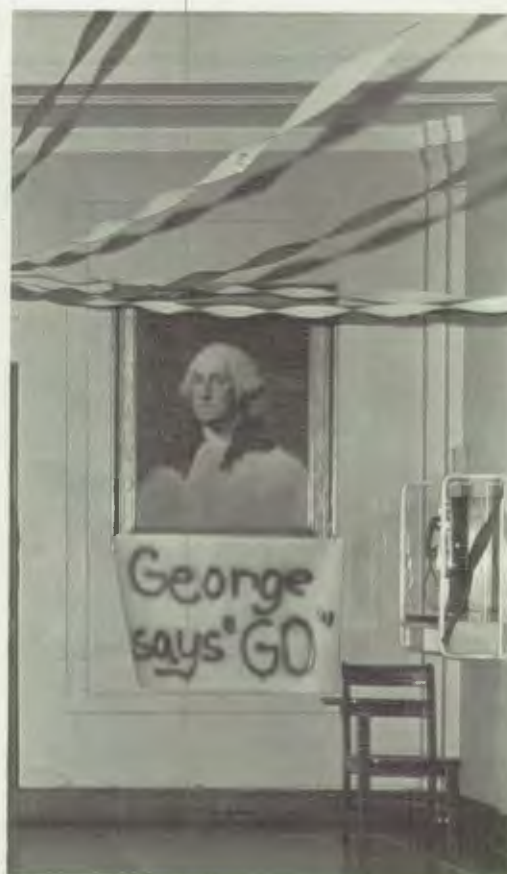

Staggs called this season "his best ever at OHS." The Bulldogs won their own invitational tournament, the district title, and the Little Six for the first time ever.

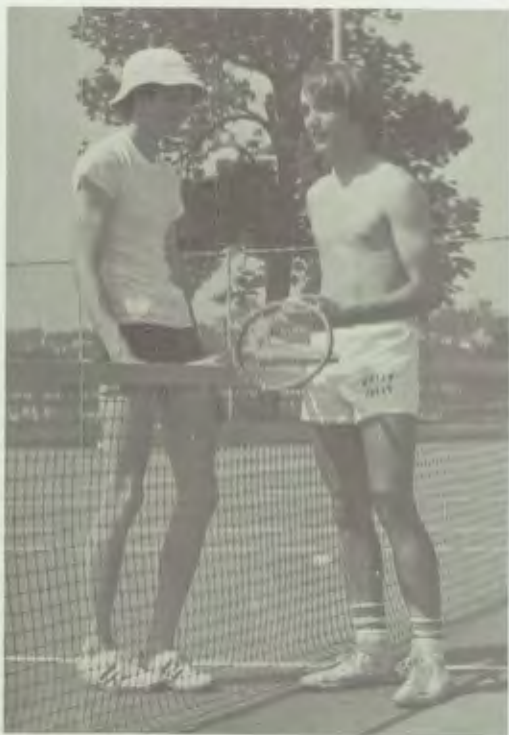
