Mick Swartz Retiring from State Center Liquor Store

J. D. Swartz, better known in State Center as "Mick," will retire Nov. 1 at the age of 75 from the State Center Liquor Store, after completing 23 and one-half years of service there.

There have been a lot of changes in the Iowa liquor laws over the years, and Mick has recounted some of them to this reporter.

"I can remember when one pint of the cheapest bourbon sold for 98 cents. However, you had to buy a permit which cost \$1.00 per year," he said. "Today the same bourbon is \$2.31 per pint. Of course, you had to be 21 years of age," he added.

Indians were not permitted

to buy a permit, and today anyone 18 years of age can purchase liquor, he noted.

In handling glass bottles there is a chance of breakage and with the handling of thousands of bottles, this has been kept to a minimum at the State Center outlet, Mick told us.

"I am sure some day State Center will have an up-to-date self-service store. The customers will not have to fill out tickets, but will be checked out at a check-out counter, the same as in a large retail store," Swartz predicted. "I am certain the question, 'Cash or charge?' will not be asked," he concluded.

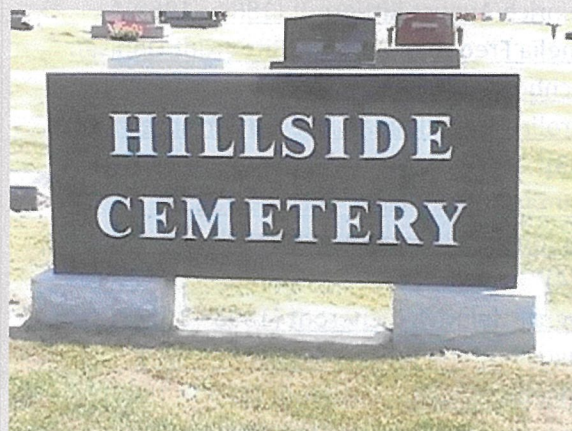

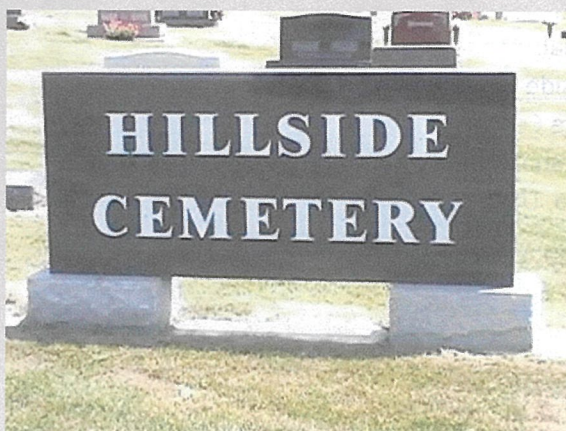
