

CEDAR VALLEY TO IMPROVE SOIL & WATER

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The Black Hawk Soil & Water Conservation District has received nearly \$500,000 from the Iowa Water Quality Initiative to start a new project in Black Hawk County to support the Iowa Nutrient Reduction Strategy and the Water Quality Initiative.

This is an innovative, outreach-based project featuring digital learning for producers to learn about conservation practices and water quality, social media, webinars, hands-on workshops and informal networking events. Money will also go toward cost-share efforts so that producers can implement conservation practices.

The project addresses the challenge of improving water quality by actively engaging with producers, fostering peer-to-peer and hands-on learning, and encouraging the adoption of conservation practices.

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
