

Trees Available, Arnold Says

Trees and shrubs for spring planting may now be ordered from the State Conservation Commission Nursery at Ames, Verle Arnold of the local Soil Conservation Service Office, said today.

Pine trees offered include four species of pine—red, white, Austrian, and Jack. The cost of the trees is \$25.00 per thousand.

Arnold said that a special wildlife packet for planting around ponds and odd areas is also available at a cost of \$5.00.

State nursery stock must be used for forestry, wildlife, or erosion control purposes. Its usage as ornamental, windbreaks around buildings, or within the limits of a city or town is prohibited by state policy.

The deadline for accepting orders is March 30, but Arnold suggests ordering early to avoid substitution of species.

Persons wanting ACP cost-sharing assistance on trees must file their application at the Davis County ASCS Office and receive tentative approval before ordering their trees. Cost-sharing rate is 80 per cent of the cost of trees and planting, but not in excess of \$45 per acre for the cost of trees and planting, Arnold said.

Anyone wanting assistance in ordering planting stock from the State Nursery may contact the local Soil Conservation Office.
