



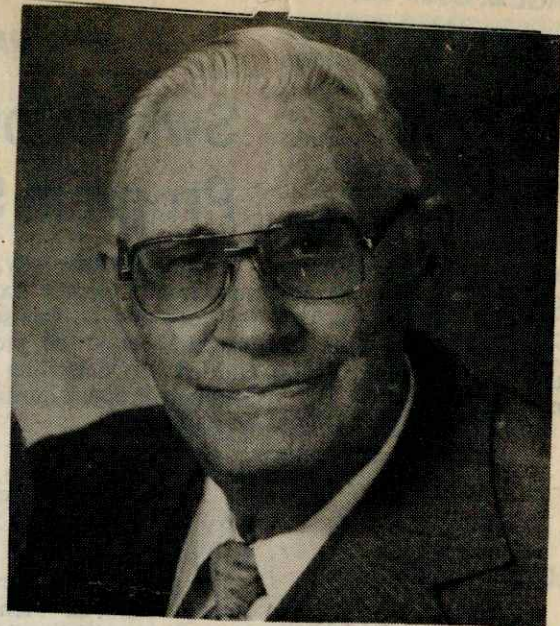
Anniversary Card Shower

John Alberts of 504 Wemple Street, Parkersburg, Iowa was born the son of Folkert and Hauka Rieken Alberts on October 31, 1910 in Butler County near Kesley, Iowa. He received his education near Hitesville.

On January 20, 1932, John was united in marriage to Gladys L. Aukes in Waverly, Iowa. They farmed for 44 years, near Allison, Stout, Parkersburg, and New Hartford, Iowa, until retiring and moving to their present home in 1976.

John was Saved on July 11, 1935, and was in fellowship with the saints at Stout Gospel Hall, ever since.
