A BRIEF CHRONOLOGY OF PLYMOUTH CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

- 1857. Preliminary steps taken by eleven men and women to organize Plymouth Congregational Church
- 1877. New church built at Northeast corner of 7th and Locust Street. Three groups went out from this church to form Pilgrim, North Park and Greenwood churches.
- 1925. Reunion of North Park, Pilgrim and Waveland with Plymouth. Present building dedicated November 1927.
- 1957. One Hundredth Anniversary of Plymouth Congregational Church.
