W. C. Hilleman Buys the Interest of His Partner.

It seems to be quite the thing for business houses to change owners these days. By a deal which closed late Monday evening the firm known as "The 2 Hillemans" became a thing of the past, W. C. Hilleman buying the interest of his partner, A. H. Hilleman. The doors were closed Tuesday pending invoicing which is now in progress, but the new proprietor expects to be able to open for business as usual on Saturday. The change was not made from personal desire to quit business permanently, but circumstances seemed to shape themselves so that retirement seemed necessary.
