Investigator Bill Piller of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office died of a massive heart attack on June 21, 2006, and went home to be with his Lord and Savior. A memorial service will be held at 11:30 a.m. Tuesday at Faith Evangelical Free Church, 3920 S. Shields St.

Martin William Piller Jr. was born April 16, 1949, in Julesburg to Martin and Wilma Piller. He grew up in Kimball, Neb., and Westminster, Colo., and enlisted

in the Army during the Vietnam War, serving as a Military Police Officer. After serving two tours in Vietnam, he returned to Westminster and worked as a police officer for the Westminster Police Department. Then, he returned to his passion of being a cowboy, working in Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska and Fort Worth, Texas.

On May 30, 1982, Bill married Roba Eyl in Greeley, and they began a family. They returned to Colorado and he worked for the Adams County Sheriff's Department and in 1991 came to the Larimer County Sheriff's Department. He only recently became an investigator, an assignment he worked long and hard for.

Bill's love for the Lord was first and foremost in his heart. He attended Providence Bible Church. He enjoyed the cowboy way of life, but he was an excellent cop. He was a great teacher, mentor and friend to many. He was artistic, had a great sense of humor and an ever positive attitude about life. Bill was a person you could trust. He was a member of the Colorado Police Protection Association; liked helping others; participated on the T.I.S.T. (Traumatic Incident Support Team); and his big heart was only outdone by his large stature.

He is survived by his wife, Roba; his son, Seth; and was preceded in death by his daughter, Jennifer Dee Piller and his father, Martin. Other survivors include his mother, Wilma "Billie" Piller of North Platte, Neb.; two brothers, Greg Piller of North Platte and Jerry Piller of Kihei, Hawaii; his extended family in the Larimer County Sheriff's Office; and Luke "the wonder dog."

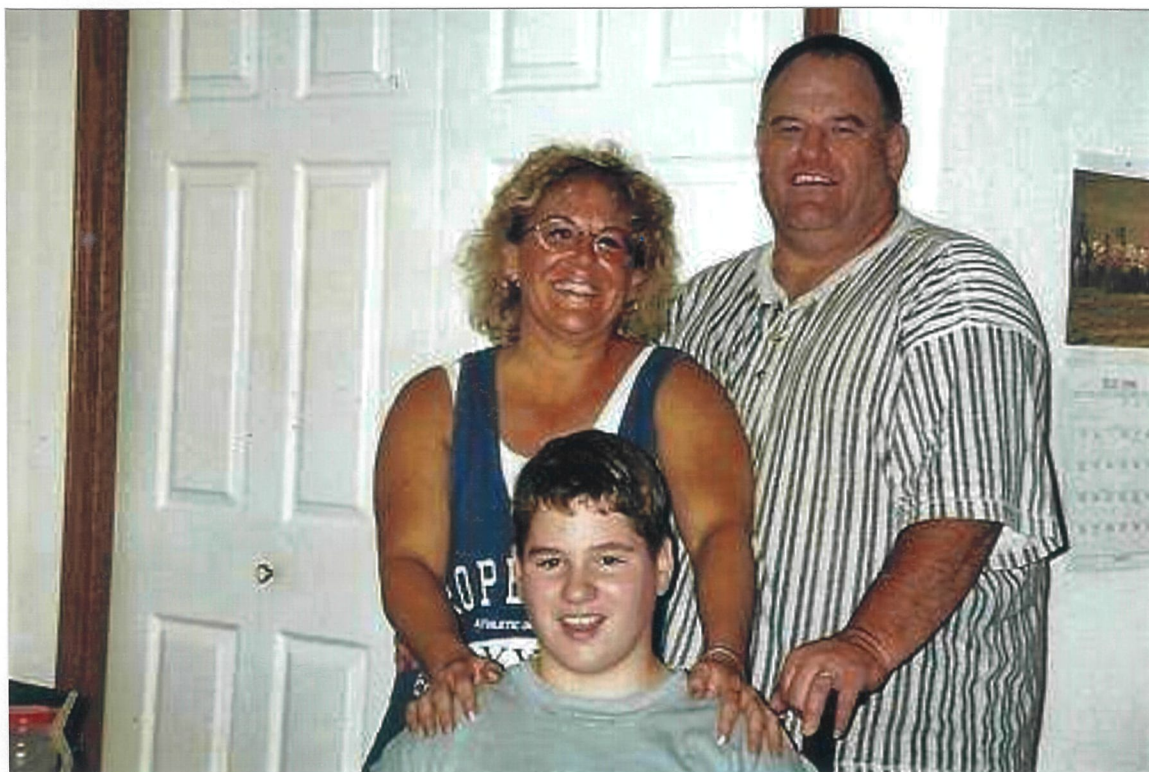
