

Award Contract For Watershed

Dec 19 - 1963

A contract for work on the Big Wyacondah Watershed has been officially awarded to Bob McConnell and Henry Burgher, local earth-moving contractors who went together to submit the low bid of \$16,841.66.

The project marks the first construction in the watershed program, mostly federally-financed, and work covers four flood prevention and grade stabilization structures and some waterway improvement.

The contractors received permission to start Dec. 20—then got simultaneous word that work can be suspended for the winter season. The project is to be completed in 100 days from Dec. 20, but suspensions because of weather extend the completion date.

It is possible the contractors will do some clearing work this winter.
