

Bids on eight structures will be accepted Nov. 18

Bids will be accepted Nov. 18 for the construction of eight grade stabilization structures in the Big Wyacondah Watershed.

The structures are a portion of part 10 of the construction program on the watershed, located south of Bloomfield.

Bid invitations were mailed to construction firms last week in Iowa, Missouri, Illinois and Nebraska.

They will be opened at 11 a.m. Nov. 18 at the Davis

County Soil Conservation District office in Bloomfield.

The estimated price range for the construction of the structures is \$60,000 to \$100,000.

Farms involved in the construction program are Dewey Harper, Frank Crouse, Ankony Angus Corp., Murl McClure, Sam Hesse, Carroll Lanman, Earl Speer, Harvey Clover, Orlo Brake and Mrs. Jim Brown.

Work on the structures is to

be completed within 179 calendar days after the date of receipt of the notice to proceed with the work.

Contractors may make arrangements to inspect the sites by contacting Sam Botts, contracting officer for the district.

A group showing of the sites will be held Nov. 3 with contractors to meet at the Soil Conservation Office at 1 p.m., followed by the tour.
