

Cost-share available

The Louisa County Soil & Water Conservation District Commissioners have recently approved cost-share for no-till planting, contour farming, and contour stripcropping. The cost-share works as follows:

The Commissioners can allocate up to 30% of their cost-share budget for these practices.

The following payments will be allowed: For no-till planting the Commissioners will pay \$10/acre up to 40 acres. For contouring, they will pay \$6/acre up to 80 acres. For contour strip cropping, they will pay \$15/acre up to 80 acres. The practices of contouring and contour strip cropping must be maintained for a 5 year period. The no-till must be used two years but can be on different areas each year.

SCS assistance is available for the layout of contours and contour stripcropping. The office is located at 514 Isett in Wapello. Phone: 523-6411.
