Lawrence William Doser of McCallsburg, died of congestive heart failure at the Colonial Manor Nursing Home in Zearing on Tuesday, June 16.

Services were held Friday, June 19 at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Nevada. Burial was in the Warren Township Cemetery in McCallsburg. Arrangements were taken care of by Fredregill Funeral Home in Zearing.

He was born on January 23, 1914 in St. Anthony to the parents of Theodore and Emma Ritterodt Doser. He graduated from St. Anthony High School in 1931.

He was married to Naomi Stackhouse on February 15, 1939 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in State Center. He farmed from 1939 to 1950 in State Center and Baxter areas. In 1950 they moved to rural McCallsburg and settled

there.

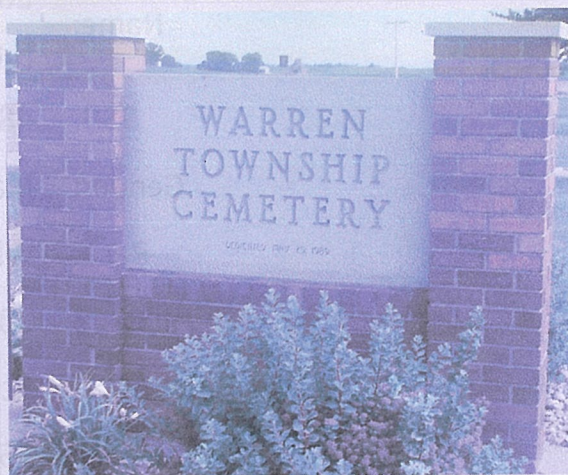

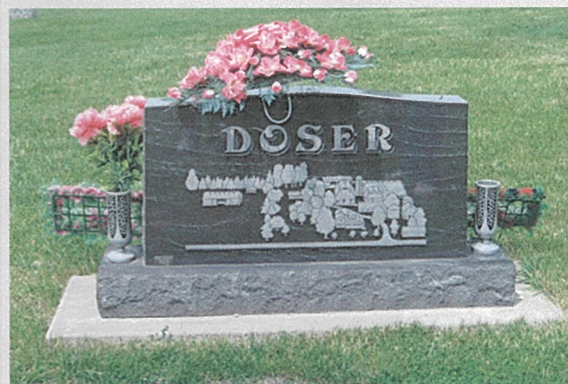

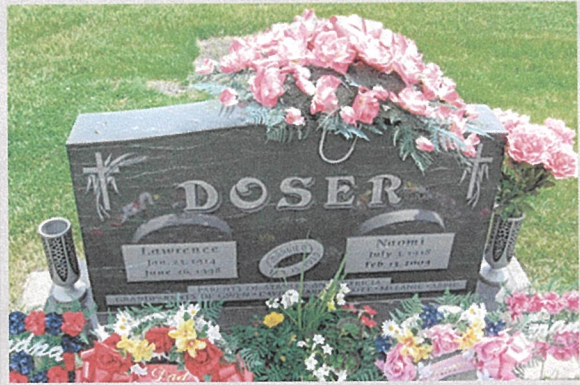
