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# First Approval Of Request For New Upper PL Road

The State Conservation Commission, during its meeting in Eldora Tuesday and Wednesday, approved a request to build an access road to the Upper Pine Lake boat docks and concession area.

The request will now be forwarded to the Iowa Highway Commission, which is expected to act on the matter this month.

The road would begin north of the Pine Lake Country Club entrance and proceed east, connecting with the present road to the Upper PL boat docks.

Construction of this road would permit closing of the present entrance to the boat docks, which divides the Upper Lake camping area. The idea was originated to eliminate traffic through the camping area.

If approved by the Highway Commission, the new road will be constructed for use this spring, reports Pine Lake Conservation Officer Milan Aschbrenner.

## STEPS AT S. R.

The Commission also approved installation of steps at the Hamboat Rock access area. The steps will be located on the south side of the existing shelter at the point to allow fishermen easy access to the Iowa River there.
